## 马州LLC税务规划讲座Ten Benefits of Setting up a Maryland LLC

Note: Maryland is ranked #35 (1 the best and 50 the worst) among 50 states in terms of tax burden.

- 1. Business expense deductions. Tip: Bookkeeping is critical
  - a. Auto, business meal, travel, and cell phone
  - b. Hire parents as an LLC advisor: Travel to parents for business; pay parents if they are in low tax bracket
  - c. Office supplies, legal fee and more
- 2. Home office expense deduction by the higher of
  - a.  $$5 \times 300 \text{ SF max} = 1,500$
  - b. Itemized: gas, water, internet, insurance and unused state and local tax (otherwise any amount over \$10K cap become wasted)
- 3. Pay the children for LLC work (1099-NEC)
  - a. Teach children business acumen and soft skills
  - b. Teach children to be street smart, not just book smart
  - c. Add LLC entrepreneurship experience into resume, Common App activity list and college essay
- 4. Set up Roth IRA for minor
  - a. Earned income from LLC (\$6,000 max)
  - b. Teach children the power of compounding interest
  - c. Teach children the virtue of delaying instant gratification
- 5. Asset protection
  - a. Injured tenant
  - b. Lawsuit from business vendors
  - c. Accident
- 6. Set up cost \$5,000 and Organization cost \$5,000
- 7. Income shifting: from high tax bracket to low (or zero) bracket
- 8. Another source of income as our Plan B (in case of W-2 job loss)
- 9. Build up the rich people mindset (OPT and OPM: other people's time and other people's money)
- 10. College campus real estate LLC
  - a. Rent to students
  - b. Child as co-landlord to file in-state tax return
  - c. Parents travel to campus as business deductible

## Top three disadvantages of LLC

- 1. Privacy concern

- 3. Bookkeeping burden
