

COVID-19 UpdateDue to Governor's Shelter-in-Place order for Washington County the Board of Directors has implemented the following measures:

- As of 8pm Saturday March 28th, Falcon
 Archers clubhouse is closed at least until
 April 6th. Outdoor facilities remain available, use at your discretion and practice social distancing. Shooting fees are waived.
- The workday April 4th is canceled.
- The ASA/3D shoot on April 11th and 12th is canceled.
- The general meeting on April 8th is canceled. The Board will continually evaluate the situation. Look for updates on the Falcon website, Facebook page, or in your email.We appreciate your cooperation during this difficult time.

Our March meeting was attended by 31 members.

The Marianne Nuzzo Memorial Shoot was canceled due to concern over the COVID-19 virus. The ASA workday has been cancelled. Remember to sign-up for ASA membership, contact Andy Hunnel. The full spring workday will be Saturday May 9th and will include field course and FITA range clean-up and repair, and installation of a French drain system.

For the upcoming 3D season VP Tim Sheriff is implementing a chain-of-command system for the three committees involved. The committees are 3D set-up, 3D tear-down, and kitchen/food. Assignment to these committees fulfillment of the duties will constitute a member's yearly work assignment. Tim will direct the committees for regular 3D shoots and either Andy H. or Jason Bischof. during the ASA/3D weekends. If a committee member is unable to make a particular work assignment it's their responsibility to find a replacement. Our March Archery 101 class had 12 shooters and we really appreciate Chris Hoffman, Erica McCardle and Eva Conner for stepping in to help. Jeff reported that we purchased 4 new bows along with sights and arrows. Thanks to Rich Paul for a sweet deal on two of those bows!

Thanks to Dan Ketelaar for looking into liabilities and other issues surrounding the club using PayPal for collecting various fees related to club business. After reviewing his report, the Board decided to postpone opening accounts for the time being. We are keeping the original Falcon/crossed-arrows logo as our main logo. Certain leagues etc. will use some of the other logos as they see fit.

Erica McCardle looked into shirts and suggested buying in bulk to sell at events. Stay tuned for ordering details.

The membership approved the club purchasing Directors and Officers Insurance protecting those individuals from personal liability. Be aware ticks have been encountered on the outdoor ranges. Use of appropriate repellents is recommended. Gretchen and Sam Graff were approved as Probationary Working members. Chris Meyers and Eric Lang were approved as Social Members.
