

Jefferson Threadheads Bylaws

- Article I – Name of the group shall be Jefferson Threadheads
- Article II – Purpose of the group is to create an environment in which quilters of all skill levels can enjoy friends, food, fat quarters, and fun, while enriching our community.
- Article III – Membership in the group is open to any person who has paid current annual dues. Only members whose dues are paid are entitled to vote.
- Article IV – Dues shall be paid annually at the January meeting each year. Amount of dues for the next year will be determined at the November regular meeting each year. Dues for those joining after July 1 each year shall be half the annual rate, to finish the current year, due and payable in full the following January.
- Article V – General meeting date, time, and location will be set by the Board. Special meetings may be called by the President or other members of the Board as needed to conduct group business.
- Article VI – Officers of the group shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer and shall serve a term of two (2) years. No person shall serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office. An officer filling a vacancy of six (6) months or less shall not be considered to have served a term. Officer will serve as the core Quilt Show Committee for the show scheduled during their term in office.
- Article VII – Board of Directors shall consist of serving officers and standing committee chairs.
- Article VIII – Nominating Committee's duty is to bring to the general membership a slate of nominees to be elected every other year for the coming term. Consent of the nominees shall be obtained prior to presentation of the slate.
- Article IX – Elections shall be held at the November general business meeting. After presentation of the slate of nominees by the Nominating Committee, nominations from the floor will be taken. If there are no further nominations, the slate may be accepted by a voice vote. If there is more than one nominee for any office, the office will be decided by written ballot. New officers will start their term at the January meeting.
- Article X – Bylaws shall be reviewed in February of every 4th year and revised as necessary. Amendments to the bylaws shall be made by a two-thirds vote of members in attendance at the March meeting of that year.
- Article XI – Dissolution of the group treasury in the event the Threadheads group is dissolved. All outstanding debts to be paid from Jefferson Threadheads bank account. Any monies remaining in the account shall be dispersed to designated non-profit entities for the promotion and furtherance of quilting in and for the community.
