QUILTS: Bridging the Past, Present and Future

GENERAL RULES

DEADLINE FOR QUILT ENTRIES IS AUGUST 15, 2025 OR WHEN SPACE IS FULL ---- ENTER EARLY!!

Entry Forms: A separate **Entry Form** is required for each quilt entered. **Entry Forms** must be signed by the Entrant, acknowledging acceptance of these General Rules. The Entry Form must be completed in its entirety (**including Quilt Story field**). Leave the "Quilt #" block empty. This will be assigned by the Jefferson Threadheads during the Intake process. There is no fee for quilt entries, and the show is non judged.

General Requirements:

- Limit of 7 quilts per entrant, including Challenge quilts.
- Quilt may not have been shown at a previous Jefferson Threadheads Quilt Show.
- Quilts must be clean, odor free and without pet hair. Quilts not meeting these criteria will not be accepted or hung.
- Quilts must be in excellent condition. Incomplete, torn or soiled quilts do not qualify for entry or display.
- Quilts must be quilted, either by machine or by hand. Tied quilts will not be accepted (with the exception of quilts entered in the Junior Category).
- Indicate quilt size as outlined on the entry form *Width X Length*.
- Make all attempts to cite pattern or book/magazine, designer or kit producer if the quilt is not an original design or traditional block.
- A Quilt Story is required on the entry form. Entries without a Quilt Story will not be accepted. Please include pattern, book or inspiration information if available.
- Quilts should not be bagged prior to delivery. Jefferson Threadheads will bag during Intake.
- Quilt must have a label on the bottom back of which indicates the entrant's name and name of quilt.
- Include a picture of the quilt with each Entry Form (Note: The quilt does not need to be completed in the picture). Quilt will not be accepted into the show without a picture. (Minimum photo size 4 x 6 inches.)
- Wearables (clothing, bags etc.), placemats and pillows will not be accepted.

Quilt Categories

Select from one of the following categories and indicate category on the Entry Form:

Traditional: Quilt made from pieces of fabric sewn together by hand or machine using regularly repeating shapes based on a grid. Blocks use can be simple, planned or repetitive.

Applique: Quilt with pieces of fabric which are hand or machine sewn or fused on to a background fabric to form a design. At least 75% of the surface is applique.

Mixed Techniques: Quilt that combines applique and piecing. Whole cloth, yo-yo or fully embroidered quilts fit in this category.

Art Quilt: Layered fibers of an original design, incorporating experimentation with textile manipulation, color, texture and/or diversity of mixed media. One person must complete the work

Modern: Emphasis on originality of design. Identified by bold color, improvisational piecing, negative space, asymmetrical and/or alternative grid work

Challenge: Created for a Jefferson Threadheads challenge – House Challenge, Ombre Challenge, Four Season Challenge, Purple Plus Challenge, Star Challenge

Junior: Quilt maker/Entrant must be 17 years of age or younger. Quilt top must be made primarily by the quilt maker/Entrant. Quilting may be completed by an adult. Quilts may be tied for this category only.

The Jefferson Threadheads reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to change the category selected.

ENTRY DEADLINE: **August 15, 2025 or when space is full**

QUILT DROP OFF: Quilts must be dropped off on Wednesday, September 17th
Drop Off Time: 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM
Drop Off Location: Jefferson Fire Station, 189 N. Main Street, Jefferson, Oregon
**** Quilts will not be accepted after this deadline ****

QUILT PICK UP: Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, September 21st
Pick Up Time: 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM
Pick Up Location: Jefferson Events Center, 1344 N. 2nd Street, Jefferson, Oregon

The Jefferson Threadheads member handling Intake will provide a Pick Up Receipt to entrants. The Pick Up Receipt **MUST** be presented in order for the entrant or the entrant's representative to receive the quilt on Sunday, September 21st. **JEFFERSON THREADHEADS WILL NOT RETURN QUILTS WITHOUT APPLICABLE PICK UP RECEIPT.** Quilts will **ONLY** be delivered to quilt entrant or their representatives during the times outlined above. Early or late pickup will not be permitted.

Quilts for Sale: If quilt is for sale, indicate desired price on Entry Form. All transactions will be strictly between the quilt entrant and buyer. The Jefferson Threadheads sole responsibility is to provide contact information to potential buyer. Jefferson Threadheads is not a party to any quilt sales and will not handle any money exchange or delivery of the quilt to the buyer.

All entries must be picked up at the Jefferson Events Center, 1344 N. 2nd Street, Jefferson, OR on Sunday September 21 between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm. It is permissible for your designee to pick up entry or entries by presenting your Pick Up Receipt. Quilts will NOT be released to the Entrant or any other person without the applicable Pick Up Receipt.
