

Supply List for Camp Attitude

Cutting mats, irons, and ironing boards are provided. There will be several design walls. Everyone will have a 6' or 8' table for their personal use. Chairs are available but they are not the right height and stacking one on top of the other solves the height problem but is not very convenient. I bring my own adjustable office chair. Lighting is now excellent. If you want to iron at your station, you'll need to bring a portable ironing surface that does not allow heat to reach the tabletop. TV trays work great.

Sewing supplies

- Sewing machine with extra needles
- Rotary cutter
- Rulers as needed
- Extension cord with multiple outlets
- Thread and notions, i.e. scissors, pins, ripper, etc

General Supplies

- Bedding, either sheets and blankets or sleeping bag. Most beds are bunks but there are at least 2 queen size.
- Pillow
- Towels and washcloth
- Bathmat and shower shoes
- Flashlight
- Toiletries
- Chargers for your electronics
- Slippers and bedside rug – floors can be cold
- TV tray to use as bedside table
- I take a camp chair as there are often no chairs in cabins
- A heated throw or heating pad. It takes the cabins about 24 hours to warm up so the first night can be a bit cool. Or an extra quilt. .

As a courtesy to your fellow quilters, please use ear buds if you want to listen to music or watch YouTube videos. If you want to share videos with someone, please step out of the room to do so.

Several of us bring cases of bottled water for everyone to use. Please don't throw the empties in the trash. There are barrels specifically to recycle them.

Two meals will be served. Breakfast at 9:00a.m. and Linner at 4:00p.m. Everyone brings snacks, savory as well as sweet. You will want to bring something that can serve as lunch, i.e., cheese and crackers, protein drink, etc. After the first day, there are usually left-overs but I wouldn't rely on that. If you like your beverages hot or cold, you may want to bring an insulated cup.

Please keep an index card with your emergency contact name and number, blood type, any medications you require, and potential medical issues with your sewing machine. I have index cards if you need one.
