
Floors can be field applied over a stable substrate or installed as tiles.


The style drawings may be used as guides, but the designer should indicate stone layouts and typical sizes on their elevations if possible.

The following information must be indicated on drawings to properly specify the products and allow the applicator to do accurate cost estimating:


- 1. Style of floor treatment (as shown on following pages, or custom style).

- 4. Stone Color.




