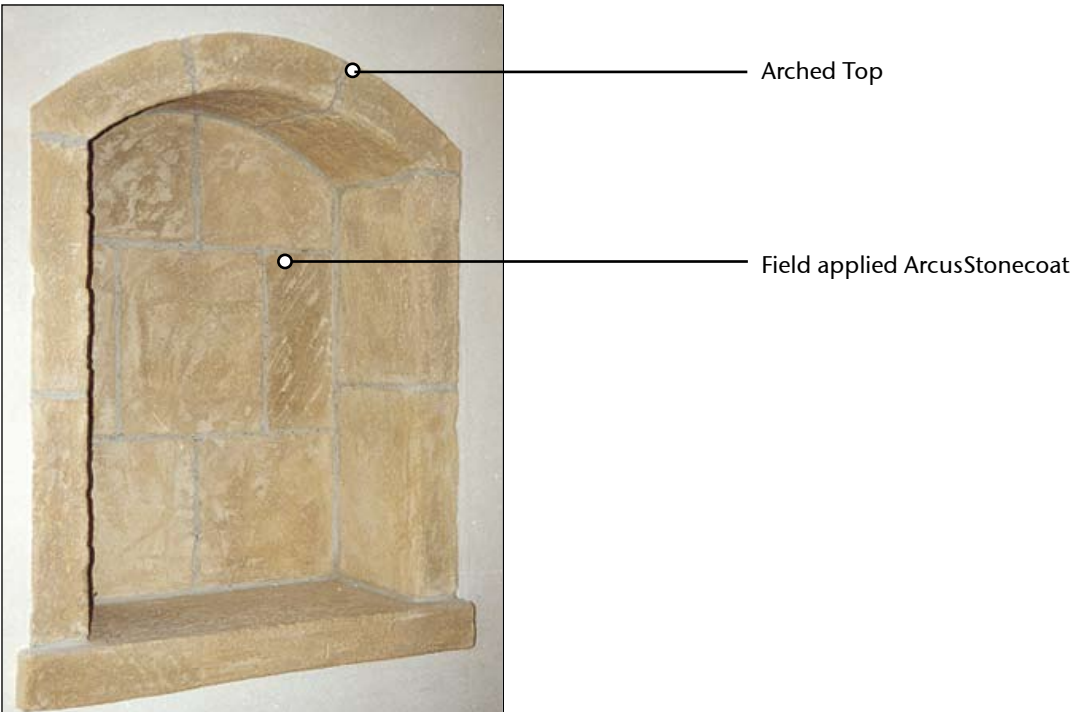


Niches



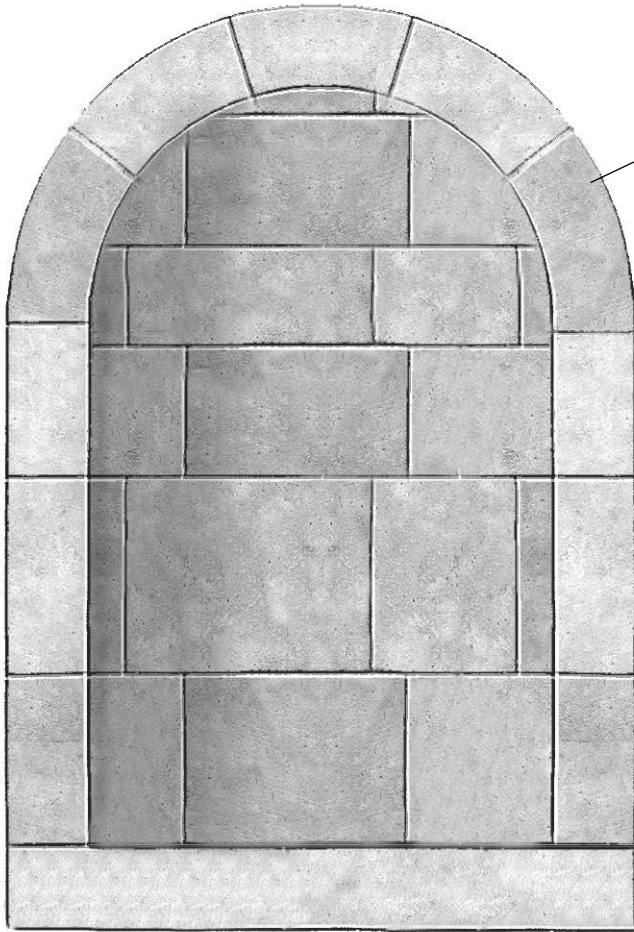
Niches are often used to frame and emphasize a work of art, a religious statue or a flower arrangement. They can be used to give depth and character to an otherwise flat wall.

The elevation drawings that follow show a variety of traditional niche styles. ArcusStone applicators can recreate simple to elaborate designs with field applied finishes, custom carvings and precast shapes. Designers are encouraged to choose a style appropriate for their project or to use the designs as inspiration for creating custom styles.

The niche's surrounds should be proportional with the size of the opening. Designers should indicate stone layouts and typical sizes on their elevations if possible.

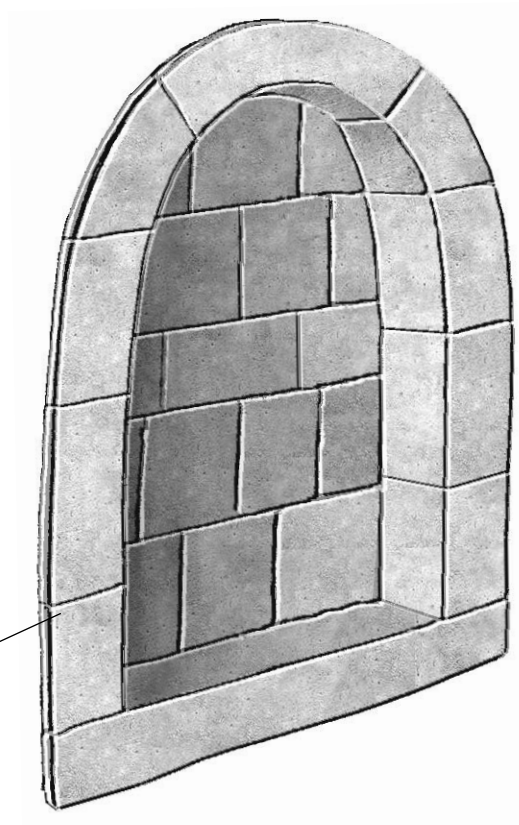
The following information must be indicated on drawings to properly specify the products and allow the applicator to do accurate cost estimating:

1. Size of niche opening.
2. Quantity of each style of niche.
3. Plan of niche showing its depth.
4. Stone Texture.
5. Stone Color.
6. Niche Style (as shown on drawings that follow, or custom).
7. Selection of cast stone molding style, keystone style, etc.
