FSA ID For Fall, 2025 College Entrance

The FSA ID-a username and password-must be used to log in to certain U.S. Department of Education websites. Your FSA ID confirms your identity to access your personal information on Federal Student Aid websites and to sign important documents. A parent of a dependent student will also need a FSA ID to sign the child's FAFSA electronically. Student and parent cannot use the same email address or cell phone number. Your FSA ID username and password serve as your electronic signature. The FSA ID is used to sign legally binding documents electronically. It has the same legal status as a written signature.

Set up unique password and confirm (8 characters, number, upper and lower case)
