

## Homecoming Dance Attire Reminder (9th-12th Grades)

Please read the Bowling Green School handbook dress code rules as stated on pages 48-50. BG Administration has no desire to dismiss a student from a Bowling Green School function and no desire to embarrass any child publicly. In order to protect the integrity of our school and our students, we ask that you read pages 48-50 of our handbook.

Girls' dresses should be no more than **FIVE inches** above the top of the knee cap. The dress cannot ride up while walking or dancing. Keep in mind, because of differing body types, the same dress may be acceptable on one person, but not on another.

Punishment for not following the rules will result in he/she not being allowed to enter the Homecoming dance. (\*\*If a BG student brings a date from another school, the BG student will be held responsible if their date isn't within BG dress code standards.) Please pass on pages 48- 50 of our handbook to any student attending our school dances that isn't enrolled in Bowling Green School. They must follow our dress code.

Please send a picture of dress POST alterations to Valarie Comeaux, Lori Schilling or Kim Burris for approval. If the dress does not meet Bowling Green School standards, she will be discreetly dismissed at the door.

The administration and faculty of Bowling Green School will make **all final judgment on the appropriateness** in making the subjective determination of modesty. Students are advised to err on the side of modesty and formality. Please do not put school administrators in the difficult position of upholding school standards or let yourself or your date be embarrassed for questionable attire.
