# Solar Light for Africa Summer Mission 2024 Information Sheet 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Mission

## Introduction

For the 25<sup>th</sup> summer, *Solar Light for Africa* will be taking a select number of American Christian young people, and adults to Uganda for two weeks of life-changing adventure and service.

#### Dates

The dates for the trip will be July 10<sup>th</sup>- 24<sup>th</sup>. The Uganda trip will leave from MCO airport in Orlando FL. There is a chance the dates will change by a day either way depending on available flights to Uganda. Please keep in mind that you are responsible for your transportation to and from Orlando. More details will be available about arrival and departure time from Orlando once the final flight arrangements are made.

## Team Leadership

The team will be led by Rev. Eric and Charlene Turner, from Melbourne FL. Eric is an Episcopal Priest and Charlene is the Executive Director of SLA and has traveled with the team since SLA's first youth mission in 1999. Charlene is responsible for all logistical arrangements. Charlene has made 35+ trips, and she is very at home in Uganda, she will have traveled to Uganda earlier to make the trip arrangements. Eric joined Charlene on in 2000 and has led every youth mission since with her.

### Financial Arrangements

All participants are expected to raise \$2,200 for Solar Light for Africa and purchase your airline ticket. Charlene will be happy to assist you in the process of purchasing your airline ticket. The money to SLA covers all ground transportation, meals, accommodations and a portion will go toward the solar equipment we will install.

Additional expenses that will be the responsibility of the participant: Immunizations, anti-malaria medications, etc. (see below), transportation to and from Orlando, spending money for additional snacks, souvenirs, etc. your passport, and Ugandan Visa, which will be purchased online before we depart. The plan at this point is to fly Emirates, which will give us a 14-hour layover in Dubai. We will plan on taking a short trip into the city to see a small bit of Dubai.

## Medical Information

Please visit "Travelers' Health" at www.cdc.gov and your personal physician for more information. All team participants are expected to get all required immunizations and other medical care including but not limited to anti-malaria medication, and vaccinations for yellow fever, typhoid and hepatitis A and B. Everyone should bring a supply of a broad-spectrum antibiotic, such as cipro, prescribed by your physician. You are responsible for proper care and supplies for any other medical conditions you may have. If you have any condition that requires ongoing treatment or special care, it is essential that this be discussed with trip leaders prior to submitting your application. Remember that you will be traveling in remote areas of a developing country, so medical care and supplies may not be easy or even possible to maintain.
