

MILLARDS CHARTERED PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTANTS SCHOLARSHIP

The committee encourages all skaters who meet the criteria to apply. As the scholarship is now being offered by Millards, the application criteria has been reviewed and amended by the committee in order to establish a basis for the scholarship.

OBJECTIVE:

To award, on an annual basis, \$1,000 to a **competitive skater** to be used to further their competitive amateur skating endeavours.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

- i. A skater whose amateur status is in good standing.
- ii. A skater whose home club is, and has been, for the past two years prior to the application, The Brant Skating Club.
- iii. A skater that has competed in at least two competitions during the past year in the Starskate 3 or higher, W.O.S. Development program or at the Sectional and National level.
- iv. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application. These may be from a coach attesting to the skater's achievements, potential and sportsmanship, a fellow skating member, a judge or an educational teacher.
- v. Skaters must also submit a signed letter from themselves expressing their interest in their sport and their proposed goals for the future as well as any results from competitions or tests.
