 - Two letters of recommendation from teachers, mentors, or professionals who can attest to the applicant's dedication or potential in the A/E/C industry.
5. Deadline: All application materials must be submitted by April 20, 2026. Late submissions will not be considered.

Selection Process:

- Our scholarship committee will review all applications thoroughly.



- Finalists will be invited for an interview, either in person or via video conferencing, to discuss their goals and aspirations in the A/E/C industry.
- The recipient(s) will be selected based on academic merit, passion for the industry, leadership potential, and the strength of their application materials.

Terms and Conditions:

- The scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the recipients to assist with related academic expenses in the form of a cashier's check.
- The recipient(s) may be featured on our website or in promotional materials to showcase their achievements and inspire others.
- Scholarship recipients will have access to mentorship opportunities and career guidance from professionals in the A/E/C industry.
