## ALOHA SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships are available to all residents within Clark County, Nevada, who will be students enrolled in a post-secondary school: College, University, and Trade/Technical/Vocational schools. Scholarship recipients can be either full or part time students and must be working towards a degree or certification program in their chosen field. Applicants will be judged on prior academic performance, recommendations, an essay on reasons for applying for the scholarship, and participation in community and school activities.

### **Scholarships Awarded:**

Two scholarships in the amount of \$500 will be awarded for the 2019 – 2020 academic year.

### **Scholarship Requirements:**

1. Fill out the scholarship application. The application is located at:

  - Print Out:
    - Print out the application, complete, and sign it.
    - Attach all required documentation to the signed application and send to the Scholarship Selection Committee (address below).
2. Maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.5 during high school or any institution attended post-graduation (based on a 4.0 scale).
3. Request official transcripts from high school or any other post-graduation institution be sent to the scholarship committee.
4. Provide one letter of recommendation from individuals not related to you and who are in good standing in the community (e.g. high school counselor, teacher, employer, scoutmaster, member of the clergy).
5. Provide an essay summarizing the reasons for applying for this scholarship, why you are deserving of the scholarship, and how the scholarship will be utilized.
6. Provide a letter of acceptance from the post-secondary school that applicant will be attending.
7. Provide a list of Community and/or School activities.
8. Send application and all requested documents to the scholarship committee:

9. The deadline for all applications is July 1, 2019.
10. Interviews with applicants may be conducted prior to scholarship selection.
11. Scholarships will be awarded at the club membership meeting on August 18, 2019.
12. Applicants reapplying yearly for the scholarship must follow the above requirements.
