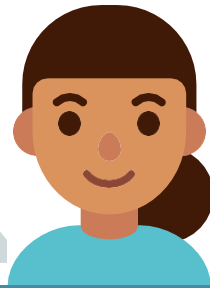

Internet & Social Media Safety Tips for Kids

- Don't add strangers or people you don't know to your social media account
- Always be very careful with what you click on in emails, the internet, and social media
- Share with a Parent or trusted adult when you are not sure or afraid of what you see or read on the internet or social media
