Thank you for submitting adoption documentation for the 2023 Sangamon County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan Update. The plan was reviewed based on the local plan criteria contained in 44 CFR Part 201, as authorized by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000. The plan met the required criteria for a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan, and the plan is now approved for Auburn and New Berlin Village.

The approval of this plan ensures continued availability of the full complement of Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) Grants. All requests for funding, however, will be evaluated individually according to the specific eligibility and other requirements of the particular program under which the application is submitted.
