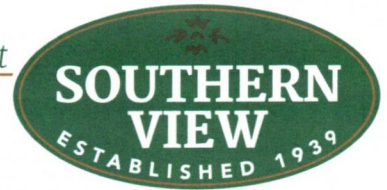

Minutes of the Special Board Meeting of the
Village of Southern View Board

CALL TO ORDER: The President and the Board of Trustees held a special meeting on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at the Southern View Municipal Building, 3410 South Fifth Street, Southern View, Illinois. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Patsche, followed by Roll call and the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Patsche apologized for not making it to the last regular board meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: President Patsche asked for discussion and approval of the Purchase of a Stihl Zero Turn Mower. Discussion took place on the badboy mowers and the toro and whether the Village can wait until next fiscal year to purchase a mower.

Motion to approve the Purchase of the Stihl Zero Turn Mower from the Village of Jerome for \$9,000.00 as presented by Trustee Richbark and 2nd by Trustee Eskew
Upon roll call vote, all voted AYE; except Trustee Petrosky and Trustee Tavernor who voted NO

MOTION PASSES.

President Patsche asked for discussion and approval of the Bid from Petersburg Plumbing on Repairing Park Drainage by East Pavilion. Trustee Eskew asked to table and asked Kevin Kuhn, Village Engineer to look at the issue and report back to the Board a resolution.

NEW BUSINESS: President Patsche asked for discussion and approval of Kuhn & Trello Finalizing the SATS Grant. President Patsche stated that this is a discussion of the SATS meeting that he and Kevin Kuhn attended this week. SATS had given 60 days to turn in any shovel ready projects but after reviewing the application the Village, any Village, would not score high enough to be considered. Costs for Kuhn & Trello to apply for the grant would be \$5,000.00. Discussion took place on different ideas on grant funds. IDOT is to do traffic counts next year in the Village on 2nd Street. President Patsche asked the Board to think of their wish lists and funding. The Village has high impact roads, St Joseph, 2nd Street and 4th Street.

ADJOURNMENT: With no further business, President Patsche asked for a motion to close the special meeting at 6:29 pm. Motion was made by Trustee Petrosky and 2nd by Trustee Eskew.
