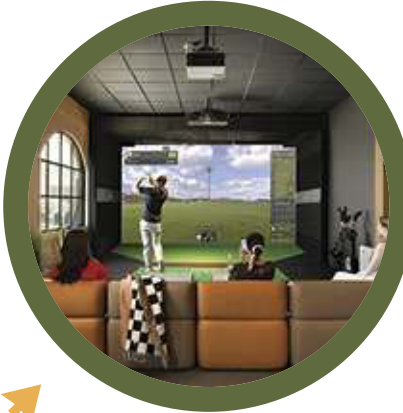


TEE TIME

TAKE A HIKE KOVACH FAMILY NATURE TRAIL

Hikers of all skill levels will enjoy this double-loop trail in the Scottsdale McDowell Sonoran Preserve, at the base of the McDowell Mountains. The level path is only a half-mile long, and it boasts interpretive signs that educate trekkers about the symbiosis between humans and the natural world.
