UNIFORM ITEMS:

- Students will load the buses in their concert attire and will remain in their concert attire until it is time to depart Birmingham, AL for Pelham, AL. Students will change once they return to campus or arrive at home.
- Make sure that you have all parts to your concert attire uniform:
 - **Option A:** Black (mens cut) Tuxedo Pants, Black (mens cut) Dress Shirt, Black Tie (optional), Black Socks (that come up past the ankles), and Black Dress Shoes (with no markings or logos).
 - **Option B:** Black Concert Dress, Black Panty Hose, Black Dress Shoes (with no markings or logos and of reasonable height).
 - **Option C:** Black (female cut) Pants, Black (female cut) top, and Black Dress Shoes (with no markings or logos and of reasonable height).
- No jewelry, no glitter, no earrings (except studs), no fingernail polish (except clear). Hair should be pulled back away from the face and kept in neat order.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- On all off-campus trips, students must ride the band buses to and from the event. Students may not change buses without permission from Mr. Ward.
- All school rules, regulations, and expectations apply and will be strictly enforced.
- Students must bring money for lunch.
- Students will be seated appropriately in their seats at all times and will remain silent during roll call.
- Students are expected to be attentive and respectful during other bands performances as well as clinics and masterclasses.
- If a student wishes to listen to music they must have headphones/ear buds as music audible to the rest of the bus will not be tolerated.
- Non-Band Members are not allowed at any time to ride the bus.
- Restroom breaks are at the discretion of the staff based on location and timing. All students will be accompanied by a chaperone when leaving the band's seating section to go to the restroom.
- Students are responsible for all of their equipment, uniforms, etc. We have Chaperones that will assist with the moving of large equipment, hydration, etc., but students are ultimately responsible for their equipment/materials.
- Students will only play their instruments as a group and will not play or make sounds on their own.
- Mr. Ward will send out a REMIND 101 text when we leaving Birmingham, AL so that you know to come pick up your student.
- When dropping off and picking up your student, please park in a parking space and do not block any of the drives.
