3:00 PM School Dismissed/All Students Go Home

5:15 PM Band Hall Opens: All Members Enter Through the Band Room

- **WW/BRASS:** Arrive wearing your game day clothing (Black PELHAM Shirt, Black Shorts, Black Band Shoes, Black Socks that come above your ankles. Make sure your hair is worn appropriately considering we are not wearing shakos. Get your uniform off the correct rack (Band Room) and report to the Auditorium with all of your materials. *Make sure you have all of your materials: Instrument, Grey Water Jug (filled with water).*
- **PERCUSSION:** Arrive wearing your game day clothing (Black PELHAM Shirt, Black Shorts, Black Band Shoes, Black Socks that come above your ankles. Make sure your hair is worn appropriately considering we are not wearing shakos. Get your uniform out of the Uniform Room and report to the Band Room with all of your materials. *Make sure you have all of your materials: Instrument, Grey Water Jug (filled with water).*
- **VISUAL ENSEMBLE:** Arrive wearing wearing Game Day clothing (designated by VE Staff) with hair, makeup, etc. already completed. After check-in, report to the Competition Gym with all of your materials. *Make sure you have all of your materials: Back Pack, Poms, Grey Water Jug (filled with water).*

- We will depart the front of the school and march down the sidewalk to the stadium. We will then go through the gate and onto the track and to the opposite end of the stadium. Percussion will remain on the track and play the cadence while the Visual Ensemble & WW/BRASS move into our seating section.

9:45 PM March Back to the Band Room

- We will march back to the Band Room and dismiss the band from there.
- After we dismiss from the Band Room, the Percussion put all materials away including unpacking the Front Ensemble Truck. Visual Ensemble will be dismissed to the Gym where the VE Staff will give instructions for departure.
- All uniforms must be properly put away and returned to the correct rack.
- Pickup for all students will be outside the Band Room (Bus Road).

ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Make sure that you have all parts to your uniform (Game):
 - Musicians: Black PELHAM shirt, Black Shorts, Black Tennis Shoes (in case of rain) w/ Black Athletic (low cut) socks, Black Marching Band Shoes w/ Black Socks that come above your ankles.
 - Visual Ensemble: Traditional (Game) Sequin Uniform, Tights, Jazz Shoes, etc.
- Students will arrive at Pelham High School dressed in Game Day Attire with all materials.
- Students will not make any alterations to their uniforms.
- No jewelry, glitter, earrings will be worn.
- Our seating section will be closed and off limits to all parents, non-performing students, visitors, etc.
- Students must eat before the game as they are not allowed to visit the concession stand before, during, or after the game. Parents are not permitted to bring food or drink to their student during the game as there is no eating or drinking permitted in uniform and it is also unfair to those who do not have food.
- Students will be required to bring their instrument & grey water jug (half-gallon, full with water).
- The use of Cell Phones in the stands is not permitted.
- Restroom breaks are at the discretion of the staff based on location and timing. All students will be accompanied by a chaperone/staff member when leaving the band's seating section to go to the restroom.
- Students are responsible for all of their equipment, uniforms, etc.
- Non-Band Members and Chaperones cannot sit in the band seating section. Seating arrangements will be decided on by Mr. Ward and the staff. Students are not allowed to move or change the setup of the band in the stands.
- Students will only play their instruments as a group and will not play or make sounds on their own.
- Students will follow the instructions of the staff, chaperones, and drum majors at all times.
- We are here to support the team and entertain the crowd! We support them and represent our school (in a first-class manor) at all times!
- Mr. Ward will send out an announcement in **ROOMS** when we leaving the stadium so that you know to come pick up your student.
- When dropping off and picking up your student, please park in a parking space in the Senior Parking Lot. You will then pick up your student in the Senior Parking Lot when they are ready. All Band Members and Parents must adhere to the Parking Procedures, etc. as they are enforced by our school administration.
