GENESIS

Lord Krishna Public School was established under the aegis of Lord Krishna Educational Society in Greater Noida on 29th June 2004, by Sqn. Ldr. (Retd.) K.K. Singh, Education Branch of the Indian Air Force, who has been Registrar Sainik School, Officer I/C of Air Force schools, member in K.V. Management Committees & Regional coordinator IGNOU & National Open School AF Station New Delhi. Within a short span of time the school has emerged as an English medium, Co-educational, providing education from Pre-Nursery (Play Section) to class VIIIth. The school has been recognized by the State Govt. The School follows CBSE syllabus, the emphasis being on English, Computer Education and Personality Development. The school follows the pattern of Air Force & Army Schools. Another branch of the school is in offing in Sec 20 of YEIDA.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The School provides modern, progressive & quality education, so as to choose excellence in all fields of life. We aim to provide complete education and ensure all round personality development. The aim is to imbibe rich cultural, social values by providing cohesive and congenial academic environment to students. The objective is to build mental horizons and broaden their outlook through co-operation, team spirit and service to mankind. Also, we assist them to enjoy their leisure hour through healthy recreational & socially useful activities/hobbies. We aim at propagating patriotic, humane, responsive citizenship and develop in them the leadership qualities by stimulating their intellectual, emotional, aesthetic, moral and physical virtues.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Student seeking admission may apply on the prescribed form available from the school. The form should be accompanied by the following documents:-

1. Birth Certificate (For Pre-Nursery, L.K.G., U.K.G.)
2. Transfer Certificate (TC) from previous school (from class 2nd and above)
3. 4 coloured passport size photographs.
4. Before admission the child's suitability shall be ascertained through interview / written test. School leaving certificate shall be issued (class 1st and above) only once the dues are paid & library books/assets are returned.

FEE STRUCTURE

We have a reasonable & economic fee structure. The Fee is to be paid on a quarterly/monthly basis within the month, and in case of quarterly payments, by 10th of the second month of the particular quarter. The fee can be paid in cash, cheque, debit/credit cards, online, or QR scan. In case of late payment, late fine of Rs 50/- (in 2nd month, and Rs 100/- (in 3rd month) shall be levied. If failed to pay within the quarter, a late fine of Rs 150/- shall be applicable. The child shall be debarred from attending the regular classes from 5th month onwards and shifted to the substitute class in case the fees is not paid for four consecutive months (gap). In case of failing to deposit the fee, thereafter, the admission is liable for cancellation and the readmission will have to be taken, if required. Fee once paid, will not be refunded.



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ATTENDANCE & PROMOTION CRITERIA

75% attendance is compulsory in the year to make the student eligible to sit for the examination. The students who have been sick for 3 days or more should submit a medical certificate.

Promotion is granted on the basis of performance in the 2 unit tests and 2 term exams monthly class test are also conducted. A minimum of 35% marks in each subject and aggregate are to be obtained, for promotion to the next class. In case of very poor performance below average, the student can be detained in 5th and 8th standards.

The medium of instruction is English. However, due importance is imparted to Hindi & Sanskrit too.

MORNING ASSEMBLY

Totally secular in nature, it begins with a prayer followed by news reading, news analysis, speech and thought for the day. The teachers also address the students on rotation basis covering broader aspects of moral values & general awareness. On specified days we have light warming-up exercises, in the form of PT, Drill, karate, yoga and house activities to keep the students physically and mentally fit. The assembly ends with the national anthem/ national song.



UNIFORM

The students will have to be in specific school uniform (summer, winter, sports) as prescribed.

SCHOOL DIARY

Parents are requested to refer the diary for any notice, feedback, holidays, activities etc. and will have to sign in the appropriate column, as having seen/understood the message. It may be used as two way traffic between the teachers and the Parents. We also have a centralized E care SMS/WhatsApp services for parents on specific/sudden important notices. Parents are advised to keep the school informed about any changes in their respective address or phone Nos. The Sofos App is to be downloaded and effectively availed of.

COMPUTER EDUCATION

The computer aided learning begins from class 1st. Children are given personal attention & teachers guide them to perform. The computer lab is well equipped with Pentium-IV, dual core computers with required configurations. Students have regular practical session on computers. Projects & assignments are also given to students to encourage interactive learning. LAN & Internet connectivity has been made available to keep the students abreast with the latest web sites too. Visual stimulus is available for Nursery children. Smart classes have been augmented for Jr. secondary classes.





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LIBRARY

The School has a well-stocked library, which introduce children to the wonder world of books. The books/magazines & newspapers are stocked/available in accordance with the mental make-up of children. Children of all age groups have individual library session, on week days, and also maintain important news dossiers.



CO-EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Wide range of co-extra curricular activities conducted in the school, enable the students to discover their latent talents. They are being trained in public speaking/group discussion, quiz, debates, projects, art/crafts, dance, karate, yoga, physical exercises, creative writing in Hindi and English. The school picnics, excursions are reinforced. Due importance is given to cultural events. The students are given exposure to various games, sports, athletics, badminton, cricket, marshal arts and yoga etc.



CLASSROOMS

Spacious, well-ventilated and well-lit classrooms have specially designed furniture, suited to different age groups. The pre-nursery and K.G. students have child friendly, round edged and colourful furniture. Each class is fitted by CCTV Camera, including the ground & corridors



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HOUSES

The students from L.K.G. onwards have been divided into 4 houses, Ganga, Brahmputra, Narmada and Krishna to enable the students to have various activities & Competitions.

TRANSPORTATION

At present the school does not have its own official buses, however, private vans are available to ferry the students from Greater Noida on reasonable charges. The facility is available for the entire academic year. These vans are private ones and the school will not be held responsible legally or financially for any injury/accident of the child during transportation. However, the drivers have been instructed to take care of punctuality, safety, security of the tiny tots enroute on a regular basis as an extra precaution. Parents are advised not to hand over their wards to unknown persons & also keep monitoring the driver's behaviour, driving compatibility and interact with the school Principal accordingly. The parents are advised to keep a copy of their Aadhaar card and driving license for safety alternative.

PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING

Parents-teachers meetings are scheduled regularly on last Saturday of the month/alternate month, aimed at helping the students improve their performance. Prior notice shall be given through student's diary/SMS.

However, parents can meet the teachers after the class hours in the school lobby, with the permission of the Principal (in case of urgent needs).

VISITORS

No visitor is allowed to contact any student/teacher without the prior permission of the Principal. Visitors are not allowed to visit the class, without prior permission. They are allowed only up to school lobby.

RULES/REGULATIONS

Students must respect the teachers & staff.

- No damage to the school property is to be resorted to.
- Students must be punctual. Late comers are not allowed except with specific permission.
- All activities/functions are to be attended by students.
- All possible precautions are taken to prevent accidents/injuries in the school premises. However, the school management will not be responsible financially or legally for any injury during the course of scheduled academic or extra curricular activities.
- Drugs, weapons are not allowed. Assault, theft, extortion, use of vulgar language, gambling/selling items etc. on the part of students are strictly forbidden. The instructions of routine nature like school timings, uniform, exam leave activities can be perused in the student's diary and notice board/telecommunications.

Collection of cash from students in any way is forbidden without prior approval of the Principal. The students are not to bring any cash/valuables to the school. Loss of such items can not be attributed to the school.
