

Rehoming and Adopting Horses

Haflinger Haven Policies

Updated 1.1.2025

Horses needing to be surrendered will be put on a wait list. They will not always be on a first come first serve basis. Sometimes a particularly serious case will be permitted to jump the line. I expect that anyone who knows me well enough to want to surrender their beloved horse will be tolerant and empathetic to such cases.

Horses over 20 years old will be accepted without being subject to most conditions and allowed permanent residence and retirement.

As always I will take horses with any medical conditions, of any age, and provide the best care possible.

I will no longer provide transportation without payment. The rate is \$40 per hour, my door, back to my door. This is my labor cost. I will continue to use my rig and pay fuel costs and meals for my drivers at my cost. Of course anyone can find their own transport as well. And tips for my hardworking drivers are welcome, give directly to them please.

Horses under 20 years old, and sound, healthy and rehomeable will be accepted with the condition that the can be rehabilitated, retrained (at my expense) and rehomed at my discretion. However, I will always consult the previous owner(s) about what is suitable.

It will be possible to provide a monthly or yearly donation to have me keep, always, any such horse regardless of age or condition. (no less than \$600 per year/ \$50 per month).

No horse will be rehomed for less than a \$1000 donation. Including pasture pets. ANY horse rehomed will Always be welcomed back for any reason. No horse that leaves Haflinger Haven INC NFP shall be sold or rehomed without first right of refusal.

There will always be a chance for conditional changes to all policies, dependent upon risk to the horse(s) and family situations. I don't want any horse to end up in a bad situation, auction, etc. plus, I understand that things happen, particularly a death in the family and other unavoidable circumstances.

All horses, either surrendered or otherwise acquired by HH Inc NFP, shall become the sole property of such.

Every horse will get a complete veterinary and farrier evaluation and will receive the recommended and necessary care upon arrival. Including, but not limited to, vaccinations, float,

radiographs, worming, bloodwork, further veterinary care and normal, as well a specialized farrier care. They will receive this level of care throughout their lives, at my expense.

Please do not message me looking for a young, sound, trail, beginner, grandma safe horse. I am not a horse trader. If I have any such horse available, I will only offer them to people that I know and trust and those that have already asked.

I apologize but I just do not have time to respond to the multitude of messages I get for this purpose. I wish you all the best in finding your Haflinger though! I can share horses that I am made aware of to those seriously looking any time.
