April 2-8

Paris:

Visit the Basilicas of Notre Dame des Victoires and Sacré Coeur and learn about Saint Thérèse's connection to these beautiful churches. Time in Paris includes Mass, adoration, a bit of general sightseeing.

Alençon:

Tour the birthplace of Saint Thérèse, visit the church where her parents were married and she was baptized. A visit to the famous Alençon lace museum (trade of Zélie Martin) and some time on your own complete the day in this charming town.

Lisieux:

Spend a day in this city made famous by Thérèse, see the Carmel where she spent her short adult life, as well as her final resting place.

Our home base during this relaxing pilgrimage will be a hidden gem in the French countryside: Notre Dame de Monligeons, a basilica dedicated to praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. Daily Mass as well as opportunities for Adoration, Confession, and Vespers will make this a truly blessed week for all pilgrims.

**Reflecting on her 1887 pilgrimage to Rome through Paris, Thérèse wrote,
"I contemplated all the marvels of art and religion.
And my soul grew through contact with holy things."**
