He suffered a traumatic brain injury as a result. The brain injury left him with left-side paralysis, limited sight in his right eye, and limited ability to make good decisions, in short, he needs constant supervision and he has suffered seizures. Someone needs to be with him 24/7. He can't drive as a result of his vision impairment and left-side paralysis. His mother and I are, his guardians and conservator. We are in our 70s and have our own limitations so we absolutely need help for Tom.

AdvisaCare is the name of the Healthcare agency that has been providing staffing for Tom. The agency is not being fully reimbursed by the insurance agency because of legislative action. Tom did not buy his policy from the legislature. It should be illegal for the Government to negate the policy's provisions. So far AdvisaCare has provided Tom's care at the current level.
