
Product service and maintenance



Place Massage Chair

Installation instructions for the upper armrest


- 1. Connect the wiring harness and trachea of A and B separately (Figure 1).
- 2. Move the upper armrest component to align end face B with end face A. Insert the mounting shaft into the mounting plate slot and gently press in the direction of the arrow Push B (Figure 2) to the bottom, open the cover, and fix it in place by hand with screws (Figure 4), and then close the cover.

Note: Comes with spare screws and an Allen wrench, which can also be used to secure.



Calf installation instructions

- 1.Insert the wire of the calf and the air pipe into the front socket of the steel frame assembly (Figure 4).
- 2. Then push the connected wire and air pipe into the hole in the backrest frame (Figure 5).
- 3. After the wire docking is completed, open the calf fixing covers on both sides of the steel frame assembly (Figure 6).
- 4.Lift the calf into the notch, close the fixing covers, and secure it in place with 2 pieces screws (Figure 7).



Installation placement

Make sure there is enough space for the massage chair can be tilted at least 24 cm.


Do not expose the massage chair directly to high temperature environment due to sunlight(such as: in front of heating equipment), and place it to where can avoid high temperature and direct sunlight. It is recommended to lay a soft cushion for long-term use in a designated location. When laying the cushion, the size of the cushion should be enough to cover Keep the range where the machine touches the floor and the range where your feet touch the floor.



Product lift instruction

Require team work to lift and move the chair to avoid injury.

- 1. Please lift the massage chair to move it on vulnerable ground such as wooden floor.
- 2. When moving on a similar wooden floor, it is recommended to lift it. Avoid damage to the casters. When the floor is lifted and moved to the designated position, be careful to keep your hands out of the way to avoid injury, and be careful of your feet being crushed. Do not let go of the unit until the unit is completely flat, the floor may be damaged, therefore, it is recommended to place mats, etc. on the floor.


Move method

Use the rear casters to move the massage chair. Move the chair by tilting it down and backward about 45° as shown in the diagram.




NOTE: Excessive force to title will cause the chair to tip over completely and product damage.

- 1.Before moving, please shut down the machine properly to reset the whole machine, and then cut off the power.
- 2.Please keep the chair vacant when moving. (People, pets or clutter will not be able to stay on the chair.)
- 3. When moving, do not cross a drop barrier higher than 2mm or a gap greater than 5mm.
- 4.When using casters to move this product, single continuous movement is not supported; if the distance exceeds 50 meters, please make this product move slowly and evenly.



How to disassemble and use headrest cushion and backrest cushion


Using a headrest cushion can reduce the intensity of kneading massage on the neck and shoulders, and you can decide whether to use a headrest cushion according to your needs (recommended to use a headrest cushion). The backrest cushion and the backrest are connected by a zipper (1), and the headrest cushion and the backrest cushion are connected by a zipper (2).


Make sure there are no foreign objects in the gaps of the machine

Before massaging, make sure that no foreign objects are caught in the legs, feet, etc.

Under no circumstances allow hands, feet, and head to penetrate into the area between the lower leg mechanism and main body, or the area between the armrest and the capsule.

Under no circumstances should hands, feet, or head sink under the fabric or leather covering of the massage area.








Function distribution

II. Start massage

1. Press the power key \bigcirc to start the massage.




Schematic diagram of the power-on

- 2. Automatically adjust the angle.
- 3. Automatically detect human shoulder position, keep sitting posture fit with massage chair.
- 4.Conduct fine adjustment of shoulder position. If the detected position deviates from the actual shoulder position, adjust to the proper position by Up

 and Down

 keys for shoulder position. Shoulder position is adjustable. If no shoulder position adjustment within 10 seconds, the massage function will be started.

Note: The Auto function can be selected during the boot-up process and the massage can be directly started.

III. Automatic program (Please use this function after power on)

1. Automatic program selection

(1) Press the automatic program key Auto of remote and select the automatic program to start the massage.

(2) Short press to change the automatic program.



IV. Manual massage(Please use this function after power on)

- 1. Massage technique, press the remote manual key Method , you can choose the massage technique.
- (1) Massage technique: knead, tap, shiatsu, knock, 3D and stop, press the manual key to adjust.
- (2) Information interface method display.

- 2. 3D intensity: Press the 3D button on the hand controller to adjust the massage intensity, with a total of 3 levels of intensity adjustable
- (1) There are 1-3 levels of massage intensity to choose from, with level 1 the weakest and level 3 being being the strongest.

V. Air pressure massage(Please use this function after power on)

1. Air pressure massage, press the air pressure key Air , you can adjust the air pressure intensity and turn off the air pressure function.

(1) Air pressure intensity: After the air pressure function is turned on, the air pressure intensity can be adjusted up to 3 levels, 1 means the weakest intensity, and 3 is the strongest.

(2) Information interface air pressure display.





VII. Angle adjustment (Please use this function after power on)

1. Zero gravity:

Press the handset zero gravity key \sum_{ZERO}^{∞} , each time you press it, change a zero gravity mode, total three zero gravity modes and off mode,. Information interface zero gravity display.

2.Full body angle:

Press and hold the seat-down key ** of the remote to start adjusting the reclining angle of the chair. The backrest will recline, the footrest will rise, and the adjustment will stop when the button is released;

Press and hold the seat-up key \nearrow on the remote to start adjusting the angle of the sitting angle of the chair. The backrest will rise back up, the footrest will go down, and the adjustment stops when the button is released.

When the adjustment reaches the limit, the adjustment will stop and a beeping sound will be issued.

VIII. Voice Control Mode(Please use this function after power on)

- When the massage chair is turned on or in standby mode, the sound "Hi Alice" or "Hey Alice" will be produced to enable the voice control function.
- After such function is enabled successfully, the massage chair will reply "I am here." At this moment, once a corresponding voice control entry to be implemented is given within six seconds, the corresponding voice control function can be performed after a reply is received from the massage chair; if no correct voice control entry is given within six seconds, the voice control function automatically will be off automatically and needs to be enabled again.
- · Note: When waking up the voice control function, please use English, the speech rate is moderate, Voice commands should be follow up the Voice entry.

IX. Operation Instructions for Bluetooth Speaker Play


- 1.Enter the smart device main menu. Open "Settings" and select the "Bluetooth" option. Open "Bluetooth", and Bluetooth will automatically "Search for a New Bluetooth Device".
- 2.The smart device will search for the corresponding Bluetooth model (e.g. IMCM-XXXX). Click the "Match" button. If you are asked whether to match with the device, you just select "Match" to complete matching.
- 3.Turn on "Music Player" in the smart device and select the song to play.

X. Massage close


During the massage, press the hand control switch key " () " to turn off. Will immediately turn off all massage functions, reset the backrest and leg, or when the massage time is up, the massage automatically turns off all massage functions, and the backrest mechanism and leg mechanism do not reset.

Cut off the power supply of the whole machine, as shown in the attached picture (the schematic diagram of the power cut off of the whole machine).


Turn off the power switch ("O" position)

Cleaning And Maintenance

Cleaning synthetic leather and plastic parts

Wipe the leather with a soft, dry cloth.

- ■Do not use chemicals such as thinner, gasoline, alcohol, etc. to clean the unit.
- ■When using commercially available leather care products (rags), please follow the instructions for use.
- ■If synthetic leather is particularly dirty, wipe it in the following way.
- ① Immerse a soft cloth in water or hot water containing 3% to 5% neutral detergent, then wring it out thoroughly.
- 2 Use the above soft cloth to wipe the leather surface.
- ③ Wipe off the cleaning solution with a cloth soaked in clean water and thoroughly wrung out.
- 4 Wipe with a wrung soft cloth.
- 5 Let it air dry naturally.
- ■When it is difficult to remove stains, please immerse commercially available melamine foam in neutral detergent, and then wipe the machine with it.
- ■Do not use a hair dryer to dry the surface.
- ■Be careful when wiping the machine with denim and colored fabrics, as the color of the fabric will stain the surface of the synthetic leather.
- ■Do not keep these parts in contact with plastic for a long time, as this will cause discoloration.
- ■Synthetic leather may be discolored, so when using hair dye, please cover the touched part with a towel.
