At the General Meeting in December we discussed the Grassley/Alexander Multi-Employer Pension Legislation. This would have a devastating effect on our NEBF Pension. It has the potential to decrease benefit amounts in the future and will penalize healthy funds in order to shore up those who are failing. It will also put our current Retirees in a position where their NEBF Pension could be taxed up to an additional 10%. The Federal Government bailed out banks and corporations in 2009 with over \$700 Billion, but Senator Grassley's bill would force pension (most Defined Benefit Pensions are Union) to penalize their participants with no help from the Feds.

The House passed Butch-Lewis, on a bi-partisan vote, which would give low interest loans to plans in trouble in order to give them time to shore up their funds. This is a compromise that helps troubled funds and does not penalize healthy ones. At the December meeting, we had cards that we asked members to sign and a number of you took cards back to jobsites as well as to the JATC. I hand delivered cards to Senator Ernst and Senator Grassley's offices and had a discussion with their staffs regarding our concerns.

I would like to thank everyone who filled out the cards. There were 185 cards for Senator Ernst and 176 for Senator Grassley. We will keep listening to the legislation being proposed and will keep the membership informed, but for now, if you get a phone call or a letter regarding Multi-Employer legislation say NO to Grassley's and support the Butch-Lewis bill. Be sure to tell our Congressmen/Congresswomen that they should not compromise on this issue. Butch-Lewis is the only acceptable legislation for the IBEW.

The holiday season is ending and our annual parties are done. The Children's Party on December 7th went very well. We had about 225 kids show up over the course of the party. Thank you for all the volunteers that showed up to help. This party would not be possible without you. We donated all the leftover crafts, gift bags and cookies to Heart of Iowa, ASAC.

The Adult Party on the 14th was well attended. By all reports everyone enjoyed the location, the food, the band and the drinks. I want to once more give a big thank you to Nichole for all the work she put into the party. Those in attendance donated \$1,548.00 for HACAP and all food items were donated to the Food Bank at Veterans Auditorium. Most people know that we have to reserve locations a year in advance for our parties and so I reserved Veterans Auditorium for December 5, 2020 for the Adult Party. The Children's Party will be held on the 12th.


