At a meeting of the Superintendents of Schools of the Towns of Calliscon, Cochection and Bethel having been notified to attend held at Jeffersonville on the 29th day of November 1852 the following resolutions were adopted

Coaks, Peter Kurly, William Brandy, Andrew Willy, Samuel W. Jackson, James P. Bogardus and Randolph Berry also the East half of Division 80 in Great Lot One of said Patent The formation of the aforesaid District involving an alteration of District N^o. 1 & 9 in Calliscon and Cochection and N^o. 12 in Bethel the consent of the trustees of the said districts to such alterations has been presented to the Superintendents and filed with Town Clerk
