A marriage license is a license from the State of New York that allows you to get married anywhere in the State. Licenses can be obtained from any Town Clerk. In order to get a marriage license from the Town of Bethel the following are required:

- 1) Both parties must be over the age of 18 (further documentation is required if they are not).
- 2) If either party has been previously married, <u>Divorce Decrees</u> from <u>all</u> previous marriages are required. Divorce Decrees can be ordered online at <u>www.vitalchek.com</u> or by calling the County Clerk where the Divorce was issued. The last page must be signed by the Judge.
- 3) Death Certificates are required if a marriage has ended by the death of a spouse.
- 4) Government issued Picture I.D.: (Passport, Immigration Record, Employment Picture I.D., Driver I.D., or School I.D.)
- 5) Birth Certificate, Baptismal Record, or Naturalization Record. (Birth Certificates must be certified translated in English.)
- 6) Social Security Number
- 7) There is a 24-hour waiting period from the date the license is issued. You take the license with you the day you come in.
- 8) The license is valid for 60 days.
- 9) After hours appointments are available. It is always best to call ahead to make sure I will be in the office.
- 10) Arrangements can also be made to accommodate certain religious practices for the Bride and Groom to come in separately (see Town Clerk for specifics.) Must be on the same day.
- 11) \$40. cash, check, money order or credit/debit card (bank fee charged for card).
