Core Responsibilities

Our partner facilities in Ecuador handle fresh bananas from tree to export, using a fumigation process with fungicides and a healing/scar protectant to preserve quality during storage and transport.

Bananas are packed in new corrugated cardboard boxes with lids. Each box includes internal cardboard protection and a vacuum-sealed polyethylene bag to safeguard the product at its optimal ripening stage.

Farnaka oversees quality control at origin and works only with SGS-certified producers meeting international volume and traceability standards.

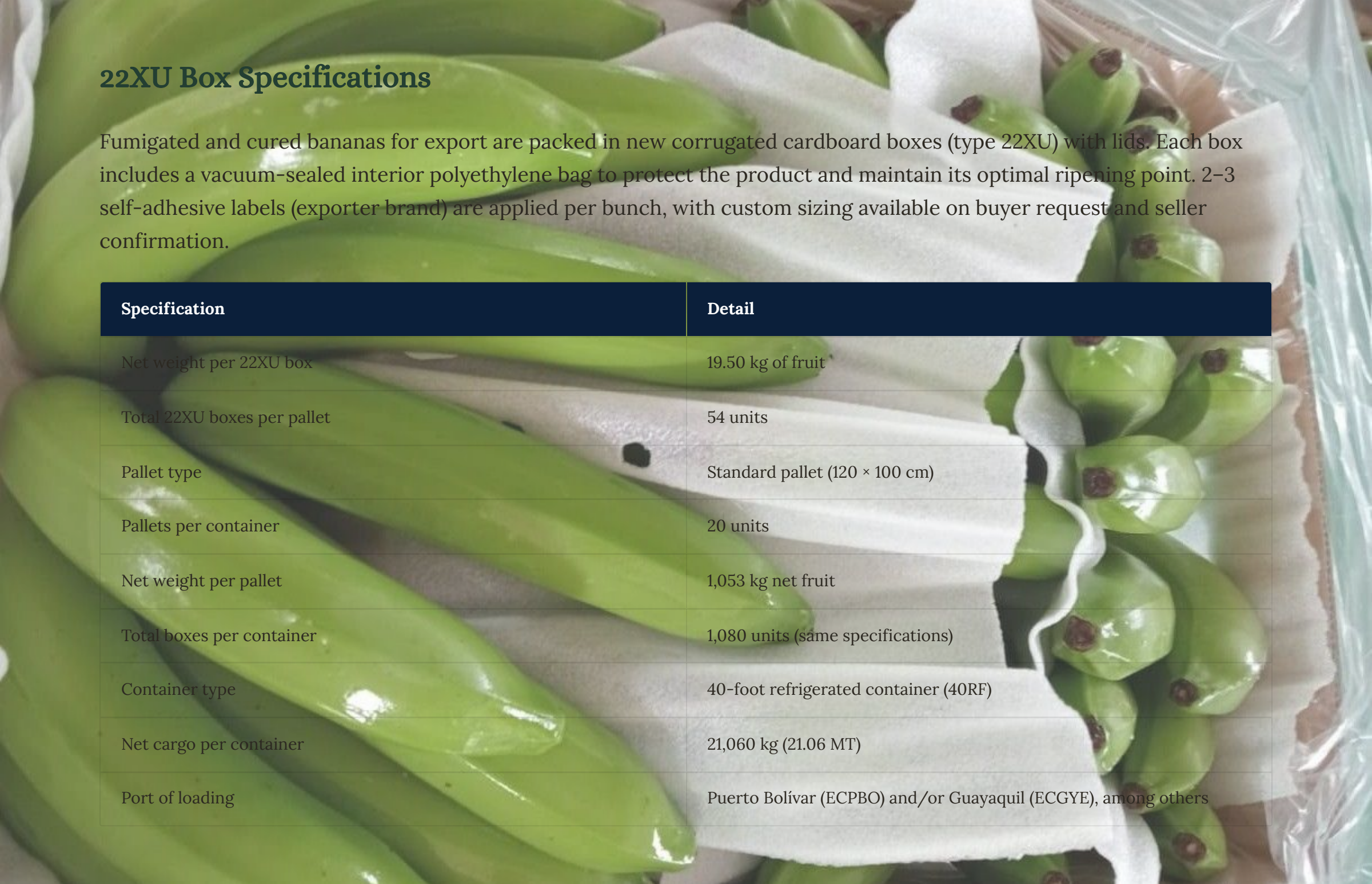

22XU Box Specifications

Fumigated and cured bananas for export are packed in new corrugated cardboard boxes (type 22XU) with lids. Each box includes a vacuum-sealed interior polyethylene bag to protect the product and maintain its optimal ripening point. 2–3 self-adhesive labels (exporter brand) are applied per bunch, with custom sizing available on buyer request and seller confirmation.

Shelf Life

Under optimal ripening conditions, cold chain control, and atmospheric management, Ecuadorian Cavendish bananas can reach a post-harvest shelf life of approximately 50 days, including green transport, ripening, and point-of-sale display.
