PLEASE REMEMBER.....

The Empress Bicycle Storage Room is always a work in progress. To help prevent overcrowding, an inventory is conducted each year in January. Currently, there is an excess number of bicycles in the room.

The *Empress Rules & Regulations*, Paragraph 22, state: "All bicycles stored in the Empress Bicycle Storage Area must display a permit and must be kept in good working condition." Please note that *working condition* does not include rusty chains, rusted wheels, or flat tires.

If you are currently on property and have a bicycle stored in the Bicycle Storage Room, please take a moment to inspect it to ensure that:

- · A readable permit is clearly displayed, and
- The bicycle is in safe, operating condition.

Following the completion of the January inventory, any bicycle that is not in working order or does not display a valid permit will be removed and donated to a local charity.

We appreciate everyone's cooperation and ask that we all do our part to help downsize and maintain an orderly Bicycle Storage Area.

Please be reminded to review the Empress Rules and Regulations for contractors working in the building and for any renovation projects.

All owners must submit a Remodel
Application and Agreement and receive
the necessary Board approval prior to
beginning any work. Renovations may not
commence until all required permits have
