Greetings Empress Residents!

A lot was accomplished in 2018 and you have been kind enough to observe and applaud our efforts in maintaining the Empress. We are grateful for the privilege of serving you. We expect to continue our effort in improving life for all who reside here while we continue to manage cost.

Please don't hesitate to let us know if you are aware of any concerns you would like us to address.

As you are well aware by now, the Association has signed a new contract with Comcast to provide cable and internet service to all units. This new contract will begin March 1, 2019 and will be in effect for five (5) years. It will allow you to stop paying for individual internet access, with speed (60 Mbps) comparable to what you now have.

Prior to the start of this new contract, Comcast will be coming to the Empress with all the new equipment needed to accommodate the new service and will change out your old equipment. We will let you know in advance when this will occur. They will adjust your billing to reflect the changes provided for in the new contract and make allowance for those units with advanced services, i.e., X1 voice recognition, DVR, blast, etc.

Other note worthy initiatives for the new year include replacing the pool and spa heaters (already done) with brand new ones, improving the efficiency of the parking lot lighting, and continuing to shore up the financials of the Empress.

We look forward to what we hope to be a year filled with many blessings for all. Happy New Year!
