As this year draws to a close we look back and wonder how we managed to accomplish anything with the many distractions and anxieties we were faced with. Nonetheless we have had some successes.

Overall, the Empress building and grounds look amazing.

Beginning with the second floor the new pool deck was paved to perfection, one almost feels its invitation to lounge and swim. The covered area has been textured and painted as well.

Both the dune walkover gate and the gate leading out to the pool have been replaced with new customized aluminum ones which have been specially fabricated and powder coated to last.

We have attempted, with some degree of success, to stem the flow of mud and flooding behind the building when it rains, by installing a concrete barrier, or curbing, as well as trenching along the sidewalk area. This area is used frequently to access the beach.

We have also had a new exhaust system installed for the generator, provided two (2) benches for the Tennis Court and new lighting for the flag.

New entrance and exit lighting have also been installed on the Empress logo and landscape.

Thanks to the urging and direction of the Social Committee the entrance and grounds were professionally done up with Christmas lighting.

The Board is currently looking at replacing the gate operating system to one that is reliable since there have been so many issues with malfunctioning clickers and the gate opening apparatus.

We are also working with the manufacturer of the garage doors to replace the panels that are rusting and are still under warranty.

Finally, and probably most importantly is that the elevator modernization is on schedule and the south elevator which is being worked on is scheduled to be in service by December 31st.

























More than ever, it is absolutely necessary for us to wear a mask, especially in confined areas such as the elevator.
