Petit I is designed to encourage students to explore their imagination; gently guiding them into the discipline of Classical Ballet while nurturing their physical skills, stamina, group awareness, and musicality using a range of musical styles and rhythmic patterns.

This strong foundation prepares students for a successful transition to our Petit II classes (RAD Grade 1/2) and our Demi Ballet classes (RAD Grade 2/3).

Dancers will begin recognizing spatial awareness of the body in traveling movements and turning actions.

This strong foundation prepares students for a successful transition to our Demi Ballet classes (RAD Grade 3 and Grade 4).

Our Demi dancers develop increased coordination, personal self-confidence, group awareness, posture, strength, and flexibility while nurturing their individual artistry and musicality. They will work toward performing with an increased awareness of technique as well as the secure use of expression.
