Stalls are \$90.00. Valid ASPC/AMHR registration, coggins (current within 1 year), health certificate within 30 days on out of state horses, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. Measurement: All horses must be measured before entering the show ring. Horses will be measured in accordance

with ASPC/AMHR rules on Saturday, October 18 from 5:00-7:00 pm and Sunday, October 19 at 7:00

a.m.

Paperwork Copies of registration papers must be included with entries. Each horse should have a current coggins. **Requirements:** Out-of-state horses should bring original negative coggins report (within one year) and health within 30

days.

Youth Classes: All youth must have an ASPC/AMHR Youth number to be considered for National awards or titles.

Youth card applications are available at the Horse Show Office. Youth membership fee is free.

Amateur An ASPC/AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$25.00 if applied for at the show. Exhibitors must be a member of ASPC/AMHR and produce a

Office.

The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The show manager will notify ASPC/AMHR of any such disqualification when the show results are

reported.

Pre-Entries: Pre-Entries must be postmarked by September 27, 2025.

Pre-Entry Fees: \$15.00 per Class/Mini. Post Entries (after 9/28) will be charged a \$25 per horse

late fee.

<u>Post-Entries</u>: <u>Post-Entries</u> will be accepted up to four classes preceding the class to be entered.
