QUALIFICATIONS FOR BOARD-CERTIFIED CHAPLAINS AND BIBLICAL COUNSELORS

1. You must be an ordained minister with the IMA. If you are not already a member, please submit IMA application (\$25) and the \$190 membership fee.
2. You must have earned a Master's degree or higher (MRE, MBS, MDIV, THM, MBC or higher) from EBCS or a recognized Bible College or Seminary
3. You must have three letters of professional reference, three-character reference letters and three letters from clients you have counseled who are willing to share your effectiveness. Also, please submit a personal resume or biographical sketch.

ALL PROFESSIONAL/MINISTRY LETTERS SHOULD BE ON THE ORGANIZATION'S LETTERHEAD.

4. Must complete Pastoral Counseling I, II & III from EBCS
5. Must have completed sufficient supervised counseling sessions or have been counseling for at least 2 years as an assistant or group leader or one one-on-one. Provide documentation.
- 5B. Submit a list of current ministry duties. Name of immediate supervisor, senior pastor, superintendent, bishop, elder, etc. Please include their contact information.
6. You must be approved by the IMA Chaplaincy Board by an interview conducted by at least three board members.
7. You must stay current with ministerial dues and be in good standing.
8. You must adhere to Legacy Ministries' Core Values
9. Pay \$25 application fee, and \$190.00 annual dues if not an ordained member of the IMA
