QUALIFICATIONS FOR BOARD CERTIFIED CHAPLAINS AND BIBLICAL COUNSELORS

- 1. Must be an ordained minister with the IMA. If not already a member, please submit IMA application and \$165 membership fee.
- 2. Must have earned a Masters degree or higher (MRE, MBS, MDIV, THM, MBC or higher) from EBCS or a recognized Bible College or Seminary
- 3. Must have three letters of professional reference, three character reference letters and three letters from clients you have counseled that are willing to share your effectiveness. Also, please submit a personal resume or biographical sketch.

ALL PROFESSIONAL/MINISTRY LETTERS SHOULD BE ON ORGANIZATION'S LETTER HEAD.

- 4. Must complete Pastoral Counseling I, II & III from EBCS
- 5. Have completed sufficient supervised counseling sessions or have been counseling for at least 2 years as an assistant or group leader or one on one. Provide documentation.
- 5B. List of current ministry duties. Name of immediate supervisor, senior pastor, superintendent, bishop, elder, etc. Please include their contact information.
- 6.. Must be approved by the IMA Chaplaincy Board by interview conducted by at least three board members.
- 7. Must stay current with ministerial dues and be in good standing.
- 8. Must adhere to Legacy Ministries Core Values
- 9.. Pay \$25 application fee, and \$165 annual dues if not an ordained member of the IMA
