Dear Resident,

We are writing to acknowledge the concerns raised by South Park Crescent residents regarding the ongoing antisocial behaviour in your area. We are truly sorry to hear about the distress this is causing and want to reassure you that we are doing all we can to tackle these issues and support the community.

As soon as we were made aware of the situation, we contacted the local police team. Since these issues, particularly drug-related activity, noise, and antisocial behaviour, fall under police responsibility, they are best placed to respond. We encourage you to report any incidents directly to the police by calling 999 for emergencies.
