SNRA BOARD MEETING

March 9, 2025

Call to order:

The meeting was called to order by President Lee Davis at 9:00 AM at the Cal Shasta Clubhouse.

President's Message:

Lee reminded the Board members to build support for the FireWise Fest, April 19. Get your community involved! A thank you to Lathem Jacoby for providing the multi-holiday decorations near the “fork in the road” at Running Deer Rd. and Gage Irving. All year round he brightens the drive in with his fun, ever-changing greetings.

Minutes of Previous Meeting:

The Minutes of the January meeting, as published in the Newsletter, were presented for approval. MOTION: Randy Tognazzini made a motion to approve the Minutes; Leo Kennedy seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report:

Invoices were presented for payment: \$46.09 to Susie Johnson for materials to replace the missing road sign at the Allen Rd. and Gage Irving “Y”.

MOTION: Faron Goodwin made a motion to pay; Brent McClurg seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. January started with a balance of \$147,926.93, income of \$3,855.61, expenses of \$441.17. February income of \$19,318.06, expenses of \$943.05. Ending balance of \$169,716.38. The Special Assessment account balance is \$200,993.04.

MOTION: Brent McClurg made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report; Randy Tognazzini seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Applications for Fee Discount for Unimproved Property. 4 applications were presented.

MOTION: Randy Tognazzini made a motion to approve all 4, Brent McClurg seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Committee Reports:

Electric Gate –

Leo Kennedy gave out the gate codes. The Board is still looking for a volunteer to maintain the gate.

No other gate or camera problems were reported.

Membership –

No new members to report.

Budget & Maintenance –

- 1) Annual maintenance. Leo said bids are being collected for the remaining \$201,000 Special Assessment repairs – primarily chip-sealing Gage Irving bypass, and for the (approx.) \$300,000 in Annual assessment

work – road clearing & patching, culvert cleaning, chip-sealing and seal-coating. When bids come in, the Road Committee will report to the Board and get the repairs scheduled.

- 2) Repairs needed at the RDR landslide keyway. At the bottom of the landslide area, below the private driveway, there has been some erosion from this winter's rains. Souza Construction has been contacted and will come out to evaluate.

Fire & Emergency Response Committee –

- 1) The FireWise Fest and BBQ on April 19 will be an important and fun event for all the SNRA community. Speakers from the Sheriffs Dept., Cal-Fire, the insurance industry and a “home hardening” expert will be giving information important to all Californians about making and maintaining a fire safe home. There is more information in this Newsletter. NOTE: There will be vendors at the fest – bring cash.
- 2) Russ Johnson reported that the Tablas Creek fire station is manned again. Not sure if it is permanent. There is currently no funding for the Fire Safe grants. The chipping crews are still available; contact Russ if you have a full day's worth of work. They are trying to get chipping done before May.
- 3) Emergency Text System – Lee Davis said all is well. It was suggested that the FireWise Fest information go out via text – trying to make sure everyone is invited.

Time for weed spraying. Ken Thomas will do it as soon as weather allows.
