Minutes of Previous Meeting:

The Minutes of the October meeting, as published in the Newsletter, were presented for approval. MOTION: Brent McClurg made a motion to approve the Minutes; Ken Thomas seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report:

No invoices were presented for payment.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. For October the opening balance was \$67,267.51; income of \$875.18; expenses of \$565.16. Closing balance \$67,577.53

MOTION: Leo Kennedy made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report; Brent McClurg seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence:

Lee Davis said he had received a phone call from Carolyn Loy from Cal Shasta asking about the SNRA policy for advertising in the Newsletter. Sue Kennedy talked with her and gave her the information.

Committee Reports:

Electric Gate -

Leo Kennedy gave out the gate codes.

There is currently no one responsible for maintaining the gates and camera. This will be discussed later in the meeting, but it is a crucial part of our community safety. Rick Dodge mentioned that the front gate needs to be greased.

No new members.

Budget & Maintenance –

Russ Johnson reported that AT&T had replaced the vault in the road just north of the lower crossing. He does not have any new information from Souza regarding the keyway repair below the landslide area on Running Deer Rd.

Fire & Emergency Response Committee –

Fire Matters – Russ Johnson said he didn't have any new information on grant monies. He will be attending the Fire Safe Council meeting this week. The Fire Wise community rep., Susan Preletz said she has not received the reports of fire prevention time and money spent by communities. She sent out an email recently, but hasn't gotten much response. Lee recommended the area rep's contact their members. The reports need to be turned in by Thursday, Nov. 13. Phil Humfrey asked Russ if the chipping crews were scheduled? Russ said that is now being done on the Fire Safe Council website, firesafeslo.org. The details will be in the Newsletter.

Emergency Text System – Lee Davis said SlickText is undergoing some revisions. He is having to do some modifications in line with the company's changes. For now, it should be available if we need it.

Old Business:

New volunteers are needed. The SNRA Board is without a Secretary. The Board is also without a Road Maintenance Committee Chair. And the Front and Emergency Gates and Camera Maintenance person has quit. Board members are trying to cover these areas, but the larger SNRA community really needs to step up. At the October meeting, Russ Johnson said he would like for someone new to take on the Road Committee Chair position. He worked very hard and many hours overseeing the major road work that was done this year and does not want to donate that kind of time again. If no volunteer is found, he will take on the position, but only if he is paid. This caused a discussion about insurance coverage which was not conclusive. The topic was tabled and will be brought up at the January meeting.
