Call to order:

The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Ken Thomas at 9:05 AM at the Cal-Shasta Clubhouse.

Minutes of Previous Meeting:

The Minutes of the January meeting, as published in the Newsletter, were presented for approval. MOTION: Leo Kennedy made a motion to approve the Minutes; Russ Johnson seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report:

No invoices were presented for payment.

The Treasurer's Report was presented:

Balance forward January 1, 2026 - \$67,403.05, income \$15,095.17, expenses \$4,387.27. February – income \$14,986.15, expenses \$10,772.78. Ending balance: \$82,324.32.

MOTION: Brent McClurg made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report; Tim Cramer seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence:

Email from Cindy McGee regarding the Newsletter publishing software. She will be looking for a new program as the current one is no longer supported.

Committee Reports:

Electric Gate –

Leo Kennedy gave out the gate codes.

No gate or camera problems were reported.

Leo has contacted John Whitford about communications at the front gate. We are hoping to get the gate opener system and the camera onto internet connections. John will come out for a site visit and make his recommendations.

Leo also reported that the document outlining the Conditions for Delivery of Manufactured Homes is being revised in conjunction with Running Deer's Board. Once RDR has approved it, the SNRA Board will vote on it.

Sue Kennedy presented 5 members' Applications for Fee Discount for Unimproved Property. They were reviewed and a MOTION was made by Russ Johnson to approve all; second by Leo Kennedy. The motion passed unanimously.

Budget & Maintenance –

- 1) Russ Johnson introduced Brock MacKimmie who will be taking over the roadside weed and brush spraying program. He has begun working, with Russ's direction, and will be getting to all areas in the next couple of weeks.
- 2) Russ said he has been in contact with Ferravanti Paving regarding this year's road maintenance work. They are scheduled to start in the first week of June and have about 2 weeks' worth of projects. The road maintenance committee will discuss the exact work and present it to the Board for approval.

Fire & Emergency Response Committee –

Fire Related Matters – Russ Johnson

- 1) Russ reported that there is still no word from the Fire Focus group on grants.
- 2) Cal Fire is continuing with the "major clearing" project creating a corridor from Hearst Ranch to our area. They have about 3-4 more years work projected.
- 3) April 25th is the date for the Fire Wise Community Event to be held at Oak Shores.
