
This requires that the user has an email address set on the user profile (see Figure 3). If no address is provided on the user profile, the user will be unable to reset the password and must contact the site Super User or **ADMINS** support to reset the password.


Figure 1 Reset Password button on the login screen

If no email is provided this is the message that will be displayed:

Contact the super user on the site to add an email address to the user profile."





- 1. Click the **Reset Password** button to initiate setting a new password.
- Click [Yes] to the "You have elected to Reset your password do you want to Continue?" prompt. If [No] is selected, the password will not be reset.

3. Click **[OK]** to the popup showing where the email has been sent.

Figure 2 The login screen with the new Reset Password button




Figure 3 The email address is set on the User Profile Screen

The email will be sent to the email address on the contact tab of the user profile table. Check the email account for the new password for **AUC**.




## 17 July 2020

The super-user on the site may view the **User Profile** [Y Login History] tab to see logon and password reset activity.




Figure 4 The User Profile Login History Screen
