STATEMENT OF FAITH

As a Christian school, we hold to the ecumenical central doctrines of historic Western Christian churches (both Roman Catholic and Protestant) believing in the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed adopted by the Second Ecumenical Council in AD 381 as the school's primary doctrine. The Creed is accepted internationally by the Catholic Church, the Eastern Orthodox Church, Oriental Orthodoxy, the Church of the East, and much of Protestantism including the Anglican communion.

Cherokee Classical Christian's Statement of Faith:

Initial:

____ 1. We believe in one God, (Exodus 20.2-3, Mark 12.29-31) the Father Almighty, (Ephesians 4.6, Malachi 2.10, Genesis 35.11) maker of heaven and earth, (Genesis 1.1, Isaiah 44:24) and of all things visible and invisible (Colossians 1:16, Romans 1:20).

____ 2. We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, (2 Corinthians 1:3, I Thessalonians 1:1, Romans 13:14) the only begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages, (John 3:16, Hebrews 1:6, Matthew 14:33, Revelation 1:8) God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, (John 1:1, I John 1:5, John 8:12, John 20:28, I John 5:20, Psalms 2:7, Hebrews 1:5, John 14:9) consubstantial with the Father; (John 10:30, Isaiah 44:6, Revelation 1:8, Philippians 2:6, John 10:38, Colossians 2:9) through whom all things were made (John 1:1-3,10,14 , I Corinthians 8:6, Colossians 1:15-17).

____ 3. For us men, and for our salvation, he came down from heaven, (I Thessalonians 5:9, Acts 4:12, II Timothy 3:15, John 6:51, John 6:38, Matthew 1:18, Luke 1:27,35, Philippians 2:6,7, Romans 1:3) and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man (Matthew 1:18, Luke 1:27, 35, Philippians 2:6,7, Romans 1:3)

____ 4. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, (Acts 2:36, Matthew 27:2,26, Mark 15:15) he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures (Matthew 16:21, Mark 15:46, Luke 24:5-7, I Corinthians 15:3-4).

____ 5. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father (John 20:17, I Timothy 3:16, I Peter 3:21,22, Acts 1:9, Mark 16:19).

____ 6. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end (Acts 1:10,11, Revelation 1:7, John 5:22, Acts 10:42, Luke 1:33).

____ 7. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, (John 14:17, II Corinthians 3:17, Acts 5:3,4, John 3:5, Titus 3:5) who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets (John 15:26, Luke 11:13, Matthew 28:19, II Peter 1:21).

____ 8. We believe in one, holy catholic* and apostolic Church (John 17:20-23, Ephesians 4:1-6, Colossians 1:18, Hebrews 12:23, Revelation 21:27, Philippians 4:3, Matthew 18:20, Philemon 1:2, Romans 16:5, I Timothy 3:15, Ephesians 2:20, Acts 2:42).

___ 9. We confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins (Matthew 28:18,19, Ephesians 4:5, Galatians 3:27, Matthew 26:28, Luke 24:47, Acts 2:38, I Peter 3:21, Romans 6:3,4) and

___ 10. We look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come (1 Corinthians 15:12, 1 Corinthians 15:21,22, John 3:16, 1 Corinthians 2:9, -Romans 11:36).

*The word "catholic" in the Statement of Faith refers not to the Roman Catholic Church, but to the universal church of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Statement of Faith does not exhaust the extent of our beliefs. The Bible is the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind along with Church Traditions (2 Thess 2:15; John 20:29-31; John 21:23-25). In our community churches the Protestant Bible has 66 books, and the Roman Catholic Bible has 73 books, but both share the same 39 Old Testament books and the 27 New Testament books. The Bible shares 5 Old Testament books with the Jewish Torah: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy. For the purposes of Cherokee Classical Christian School's doctrine, faith, practice, behavioral standards, policy, and discipline, our board is the final interpretive authority on the Bible's application. Statement of Faith is to be inclusive of the Statement on Sanctity of Life, Marriage, and Sexuality.

STATEMENT ON SANCTITY OF LIFE, MARRIAGE, AND SEXUALITY

Initial:

___ 1. We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically and mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life (Genesis 1:26-27, 5:1; Psalm 139:13-16; Exodus 20:13; Psalm 127:3).

___ 2. We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complimentary sexes together reflect the image and nature of God (Genesis 1:26-17). Rejection of one's biological sex is the rejection of the image of God within that person (Psalm 139:13). We will at all times interact with members of the school community according to their biological sex. Cherokee Classical Christian School encourages individuals struggling with their sexual identity to seek help from their pastor and other trained professionals who might assist them to clarify their sexual identity in accordance with God's Word.

___ 3. We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture (Genesis 2:18-25). We believe that marriage between one man and one woman, for life, uniquely reflects Christ's relationship with His Church (Ephesians 5:21-33). We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other (1 Corinthians 6:18; 7:2-5; Hebrews 13:4). We believe that God commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of marriage between a man and a woman (Leviticus 20:10).

____ 4. We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, and use of pornography) is contrary to the Bible's teaching, is sinful, and offensive to God (Romans 12:1-2; I Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:1-7; I Thessalonians 4:3-8; I Timothy 4:12; II Timothy 2:19-22; I Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; Leviticus 20:10-17).

____ 5. We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity (Mark 12:28-31; Luke 6:31) and assist those we love in doing the same (Ephesians 4:15). Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are not allowed, are to be repudiated, and are not in accord with Scripture and the beliefs of Cherokee Classical Christian.

____ 6. We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of Cherokee Classical Christian as a Christian school under the authority of the Scriptures, and to provide a biblical role model to our students and school community, it is imperative that all persons employed by Cherokee Classical Christian in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers in any capacity, agree to and abide with unreserved acceptance to the Statement of Faith and the Statement on Sanctity of Life, Marriage, and Sexuality (Matt 5:16, Phil 2:14-16, 1 Thess 5:22).

DOCTRINAL IDENTITY

The substance of Cherokee Classical Christian's Statement of Faith/Statement on Sanctity of Life, Marriage, and Sexuality is that which will be considered primary doctrine at the school. Beyond the primary doctrines articulated in the Statement of Faith/Statement on Sanctity of Life, we respect and acknowledge the primacy of local churches and families and refer any secondary doctrinal questions to local churches and parents (for example, sacraments, infant baptism, immersion baptism, transfiguration, etc.). Secondary or potentially divisive doctrines and issues will not be presented as primary doctrine. We embrace the ecumenical historic tenets of the Western Christian churches (both Roman Catholic and Protestant) as articulated in the creeds of the early churches. It is mandatory that all board members, school administrators, school faculty and staff subscribe with unreserved acceptance to the Statement of Faith/Statement on Sanctity of Life, Marriage, and Sexuality and actively serve Christ under the authority of a local Christian church that is in essential agreement with this Statement of Faith/Statement on Sanctity of Life, Marriage, and Sexuality.

Parents and legal guardians who choose to enroll their children at Cherokee Classical Christian School are agreeing to support these and other basic biblical values derived from historic Western Christian churches (both Roman Catholic and Protestant) believing in the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed adopted by the Second Ecumenical Council in AD 381, under whose authority Cherokee Classical rests. Parents understand and agree that Cherokee Classical Christian School will teach these principles and biblical values. In addition, the board of directors urge parents to recognize their scriptural responsibility to provide their children with a Christian education and to understand that the primary responsibility for this task rests with parents (Deuteronomy 6:1-9, Psalm 78:5-6 Proverbs 22:6, Ephesians 6:4).

Cherokee Classical was founded and continues to operate upon biblical values and the desire and commitment for Bible-believing Christian parents to enroll their children in an intentionally Christian environment.
