## Edward F. Moore, Ed.D.

Edward (Ed) Moore was raised in Barnwell, South Carolina by parents E.T. (Tim) Moore, Jr and Frances Scott (Scottie) Turner Moore. He attended Barnwell School District 45 public schools and graduated from Barnwell High School in 1995.

He attended Auburn University on a U.S. Army ROTC Scholarship majoring in Secondary Education. He graduated and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in 2000. While serving on active duty, he served as a Tank Platoon Leader in C Co 2/72 Armor Battalion as part of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division in Camp Casey, South Korea. He later transitioned to serve as the Assistant Garrison S-3 Operations Officer for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, GA. After separating from active duty, he continued to serve in the South Carolina National Guard before completing his military commitment, earning the rank of Captain (O-3).



Ed pursued higher education and earned his Master of Education in Educational Leadership from Georgia Southern University in 2004. He later attended Liberty University earning a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership in 2017. During his studies, he published research comparing multi-dimensional work ethic profiles of high school athletes and non-athletes. He has continued his involvement in higher education by serving on the inaugural faculty of Columbia College's Masters of Coaching degree program and as a visiting professor of Athletic Leadership at Clemson University.

Dr. Moore's primary profession has been in Public Secondary Education and currently serves as an Assistant Principal in Richland School District Two. Previously he has taught Chemistry, Physics, and Physical Education. He has also served as a Head Football Coach, Athletic Director, Student Graduation Specialist and Principal.

Dr. Moore resides in Columbia with his son, Graydon. They attend Downtown Church in Columbia. Despite his primary residence being in Columbia, he has always considered home to be Snelling, South Carolina and is honored to serve the needs of his home communities.
