





The unemployment rate, which had been hovering at 50-year lows before the disease hit, was better than the 16 per cent economists had expected but sharply higher from just 4.4 per cent in March and its peak of 10 per cent during the 2008-90 financial crisis. During the Great Depression it was estimated to have reached about 25 per cent.

"The prospect of a V-shaped recovery is absolutely zero," said James Knightley, chief international economist with ING. "Getting 40m jobs returning in the next 12 months? I simply cannot see it happening."

Governments are failing to keep accurate records of infections and deaths of nurses and health care workers treating coronavirus patients, the International Council of Nurses (ICN), a federation representing nurses from 130 countries, claimed.

As a result, the numbers are being "significantly" underestimated, the ICN said Monday. Data collected by the ICN from 30 countries suggests at least 90,000 health care workers have been infected and more than 260 nurses have died.

"Thousands of nurses have been infected with Covid-19 and hundreds have already died, but governments cannot say exactly how many because they are not collecting the data. This lack of accurate data has led to a serious underestimation of the infection rate among nurses, and the number of deaths," the group said.



Globally, the electricity sector attracts more than \$750 billion in investments annually. Much of the sector's investment portfolio comprises renewable energy and grid infrastructure. The demand in the power sector and the impact on prices need to be analyzed carefully to ensure continuity in investment in these areas, which constitute the cornerstone of energy transition along with energy efficiency.

Electricity generation from renewable resources met forty-four percent of Turkey's total electricity demand by the end of 2019, with wind and solar energy representing around ten percent.

According to the statistics released by the International Renewable Energy Agency in March, renewables accounted for three-quarters of the new capacity additions in the global power sector in 2019. Wind and solar energy—with continuing cost reductions—were the majority of them.




