



Dress Code

Boys Uniform Policy:

- School uniform shirt in red or black with school logo purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
- School logo sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, and hoodies only purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz.
- School uniform shirt must be worn under the sweatshirt, hoodie, or sweater at all times
- Shorts or pants in beige or black ONLY - no navy
 - No pockets, zippers, or carpenter loops on the sides of the legs, such as cargo pants or cargo shorts
 - Spandex, leggings, sweatpants, or stretch pants may be worn under shorts ONLY - Solid red and black only - NO designs
 - Sweatpants may be worn on PE days only - in either school logo or solid black
- Shirts are to be tucked in at all times
- Belts are to be worn at all times (First - Twelfth Grade Only)
- Hair should be neatly groomed. Must be a natural color
 - Cannot touch back collar of shirt or be long enough to “curl up” in the back
 - Cannot come over the ears
 - Sideburns neatly trimmed and no longer than mid ear length
 - Cannot touch eyebrows
 - Rat tails, punk, mohawks, mullets, spiking, worldly trends, shaving, dying, bleaching, design/razor cutting, or unnatural hair colors are not permitted
- Socks that will be seen are to be red, black, or white ONLY
- Tennis shoes are to be worn
 - No flip flops, crocs, thong-type sandals, or slides are allowed
- No tattoos of any kind
- No jewelry of any kind, unless approval is given from the administration
 - No body or facial piercings

Physical Education (PE):

- Shirt - Grey or red PE t-shirt with DBCA screen-printed school logo purchased from Blazin Creationz
- Shorts - Black PE shorts with DBCA school logo purchased from Blazin Creationz (ONLY WORN ON PE DAY)
- Sweatpants - Black sweatpants with DBCA school logo purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz (ONLY WORN ON PE DAY)
- Tennis shoes are mandatory on PE days or student will sit out and receive a 0 for participation for the day
- Grades will be taken for students on their PE dress code compliance

Consequences:

- First notice - alert sent through MySchoolWorx
- Second notice - parent call and student will be required to change
- Third notice - 1 day detention with writing assignment
- Fourth notice - 1 day in-school suspension with parent meeting
- Fifth notice - further action by decision of administration

Teacher and/or administration has the ability to approve changes to these dress code rules, as they deem necessary.
