



Dress Code

Girls Uniform Policy:

- School uniform shirt in red or black with school logo purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
- School logo sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets and hoodies only purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz. School uniform shirt must be worn under the sweatshirt, hoodie, or sweater at all times.
- Jumpers, skorts, shorts, or pants in beige and black only purchased from our vendor - French Toast
 - NO spandex, leggings, sweatpants, or stretch pants unless worn under jumpers, skirts and shorts - Solid red and black only - NO designs
 - Sweatpants may be worn on PE days only - in either school logo or solid black
- Shirts are to be tucked in at all times. If the pants have belt loops, then a belt is to be worn as well
- Hair should be neatly groomed. Must be a natural color
 - No punk, worldly trends, dyed, bleached, shaved, masculine haircut or hair in unnatural colors (pink, green, orange, etc.)
- Socks that will be seen are to be red, black, or white ONLY
- Tennis shoes or sandals, with a strap across the back, are to be worn
 - No flip flops, crocs, thong-type sandals, slides
 - Heels should be no more than 2"
- No tattoos of any kind
- Jewelry should be worn in good taste
 - Earrings must be matching - no longer than 1" below the earlobe - only two matching earrings in each earlobe allowed
 - No more than 2 bracelets
 - No body or facial piercing
- Makeup should be worn in modest tones (6th-12th grade only)

Physical Education (PE):

- Grey PE shirt with DBCA screen-printed school logo purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
- Black PE shorts with DBCA school logo OR Black sweatpants with DBCA school logo (ONLY WORN ON PE DAY) purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
- Tennis shoes only are to be worn on PE days.
- Grades will be taken for students on their PE dress code compliance.

Consequences:

- First notice - written warning requiring parent signature
- Second notice - parent call and student will be required to change
- Third notice - 1 day detention with writing assignment
- Fourth notice - 1 day in-school suspension with parent meeting
- Fifth notice - further action by decision of administration

Teacher and/or administration has the ability to approve changes to these dress code rules, as they deem necessary.



Dress Code

Boys Uniform Policy:

- School uniform shirt in red or black with school logo purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
- School logo sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, and hoodies only. School uniform shirt must be worn under the sweatshirt, hoodie, or sweater at all times
- Shorts or pants in beige and black only purchased from our vendor - French Toast
 - No pockets on the sides of the legs, such as cargo pants or cargo shorts
 - Sweatpants may be worn on PE days only - in either school logo or solid black
- Shirts are to be tucked in at all times
- Belts are to be worn at all times
- Hair should be neatly groomed. Must be a natural color
 - Cannot touch back collar of shirt or be long enough to “curl up” in the back
 - Cannot come over the ears
 - Sideburns neatly trimmed and no longer than mid ear length
 - Cannot touch eyebrows
 - Rat tails, punk, mohawks, mullets, spiking, worldly trends, shaving, dying, bleaching, design/razor cutting, or unnatural hair colors are not permitted
- Socks that will be seen are to be red, black, or white ONLY
- Tennis shoes are to be worn
 - No flip flops, crocs, thong-type sandals, or slides are allowed
- No tattoos of any kind
- No jewelry of any kind, unless approval is given from the administration
 - No body or facial piercings

Physical Education (PE):

- Grey PE shirt with DBCA screen-printed school logo - purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
- Black PE shorts with DBCA school logo OR Black sweatpants with DBCA school logo (ONLY WORN ON PE DAY) purchased from our vendor - Blazin Creationz
