

2024 DCPASR Free Pre-retirement Workshop Event

This year, DCPASR moved our FREE Pre-retirement Workshop to **Faith Immanuel Presbyterian Church on 1801 Colonial Road in Harrisburg**. The event took place on Saturday April **5, 2025, from 9 am -12 noon**, on a dreary, rainy, and damp Saturday.

Behind the scenes, our team was busy making contacts with DC School administrators to distribute our flyer to their staff, setting up for the day of the event and checking-in our registrants. We had seventy-four people register online, representing nine out of twelve Dauphin County School Districts. We checked-in fifty-nine participants on the day of the event.

The audience was made up of public-school employees including teachers, librarians, counselors, nurses, administrators, aides, paraprofessionals, office staff, cafeteria, maintenance workers, transportation, and bus drivers. Doors opened at 8:15 am for check-in and picking up materials for the presentations.

Bob Hamera, Technology, had our DCPASR PowerPoint presentation on a loop to run continuously while participants took their seats and waited for the workshop to begin. This PP lets people know who we are, the types of memberships we have available, what activities we do socially, and how we give back to our members, our schools, and our communities. Margaret Auten, DCPASR President, served as our Moderator for the event. She shared information about our chapter and how our participants can take advantage of our grant money, scholarships, and awards of excellence. Margaret introduced our speakers and the team who put this event together. Kelly Dygart, PASR Administrative Officer, used a PowerPoint presentation to talk about our state organization PASR, emphasizing who we are, our mission, membership options, and benefits that come with state membership including Vision & Dental Insurance.

John Tucker, Southcentral Regional Office Administrator for PSERS, showed slides on determining pension eligibility, retirement pension options available to them & a checklist with time frame on what needs to get done before their exit counseling.

Doug Bonsall, PSERS Health Option Program Representative/Consultant discussed eligibility for HOP, including age, spousal coverage, and premium assistance available, also several types of Health Insurance options, Drug Coverages, MetLife Dental & Eye Med Vision Insurances in his presentation.

The participants learned how to navigate through the PSERS Retirement System to pick options for their pension, and the insurance coverages available to them through HOP and PASR. The participants found the experience worthwhile as we heard many positive comments as they exited the event. A few realized they had to stay another year, while others were surprised by how much they had to do before they retired or even wait another year to retire. Several told us we give the best workshop around!
