Day 1: Monday, May 11, 2026

Springtime is a beautiful time to visit Ottawa! We overnight in Syracuse, NY and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, savoring a relaxing evening. With Ottawa's Tulip Festival on the horizon, the journey is already blooming with anticipation. **(Dinner)**

Day 2: Tuesday, May 12, 2026

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll head north through spring-green landscapes toward **Ottawa** and arrive in Ottawa by afternoon. Stretch your legs with a visit to the renowned **Byward Market**, Canada's oldest and largest public market and the city's premier destination for shopping, dining, arts and entertainment. The architecture and variety of shops and boutiques are simply amazing. The Market will be dressed in its spring best with tulip-inspired art installations and animations.

Day 3: Wednesday, May 13, 2026

After breakfast, board the coach and head out with your local guide for a 2-hour **Ottawa windshield tour**. The costumed guide, portraying a historical character, will take you by the Capitol, the Eternal Flame, the lookout at the Museum of Civilization, the Prime Minister's residence, the Rockcliffe District and more.

Next, meet an official guide and embark on a guided tour of **Canada's Parliament Buildings**. This gorgeous Gothic-style structure overlooks the Ottawa River and sits on top of Parliament Hill. There are hundreds of individual gargoyles, grotesques, reliefs and bosses carved into the stonework of the buildings. Enjoy an included lunch at a local restaurant.

Then step behind the scenes at the **Royal Canadian Mounted Police Stables** in Ottawa, where Canada's iconic Mounties prepare their world-famous Musical Ride. Visitors are greeted by the sight of majestic black horses and the crisp gleam of polished saddles. Knowledgeable guides share stories of the RCMP's proud traditions, from meticulous training routines to the deep bond between rider and horse. The scent of hay mingles with the sound of hooves on the stable floor, offering a rare and memorable glimpse into this living symbol of Canadian heritage.

Enjoy all that the **Tulip Festival** has to offer. Enjoy the rest of your afternoon at the Tulip Festival. The festival is the largest of its kind in the world and showcases over a million tulips across Ottawa. Travelers may scatter to access the other gardens via the "Tulip Express Shuttle." The price of one "Tulip Toonie" each way is included in your package. The shuttle will comfortably transport you to the main tulip beds in Commissioner's Park at Dow's Lake and to Lansdowne Park beside the Rideau Canal. The festival not only

showcases beautiful gardens but also offers indoor and outdoor spaces with photo exhibits, workshops with artisans, international live performances, a café and events!

Enjoy dinner on your own in Downtown Ottawa.

Day 4: Thursday, May 14, 2026

Start the day with breakfast at the hotel before checking out and traveling to Niagara Falls. As you draw closer to Niagara, the scenery grows more dramatic—rivers rushing toward their destination, tree-lined roads arching overhead, and the distant hum of water hinting at what's to come.

Then take a **Journey Behind the Falls**. A popular attraction in Niagara Falls, Canada, where visitors descend tunnels to stand directly behind the massive Horseshoe Falls. Tonight, enjoy dinner overlooking the Falls at **Skylon Tower**. Dinner at the Skylon Tower offers a revolving dining experience with breathtaking panoramic views of Niagara Falls and the city skyline. Guests enjoy fine cuisine in an elegant setting as the restaurant completes a full 360-degree rotation every hour.

Enjoy the **Niagara Falls Illumination**. Each evening, the mighty Niagara Falls transforms into a breathtaking canvas of color and light. The cascading waters shimmer in brilliant hues—deep sapphire, ruby red, emerald, green, and golden amber—casting a magical glow over the mist. Step back in time with a visit to the **Niagara Falls Underground Railroad Heritage Center** which immerses you in the stories of freedom seekers and abolitionists, focusing on the

Located in the historic 1863 U.S. Customs House, the museum's exhibits, such as "One More River to Cross," use digital media and scenic built environments to highlight the experiences of individuals like Harriet Tubman and the African American waiters who risked their lives to help others cross the Niagara River.

Lunch will be on your own at **Table Rock Market**. Find delicious and convenient culinary delights just steps from the brink of the Horseshoe Falls at the all-new Table Rock Market, inside Table Rock Centre.

After lunch, we make our way to the **Erie Canal** for an incredibly fun, narrated, 90-minute cruise through history on the calm waters of the Erie Canal. Enjoy the spectacular scenery of New York's beautiful Mohawk Valley. The thrill of our voyage is being raised and lowered over 20 feet in an Erie Canal lock!

Check into Auburn, NY hotel for the night. Dinner is included at the hotel this evening.


Day 6: Saturday, May 16, 2026
