LEGISLATIVE REPORT

U.S. **CONGRESS** Our currently discussing prescription drug prices. Drug prices have been going up and we hope our Congress will put a halt to this practice. The U.S. CONGRESS needs to bid our prescription drugs on the open market. The VETERANS ADMINISTRATION bids out prescription drugs and they get low prices for veterans. CONGRESS should do the same for the American taxpayer. Contact U.S. Senators BOB CASEY AND PAT TOOMEY to help in this cause. Also contact your U.S. REPRESENTATIVE in your area. U.S. REP. SCOTT PERRY covers DAUPHIN, CUMBERLAND AND NORTHERN YORK counties.

Our STATE Legislature is currently discussing a bill that would raise the starting salary for teachers to \$45,000. Most of our STATE Legislators have a problem with this salary. I can say I have a problem with our STATE Legislators and their starting salary. Did you know that our STATE Legislators started this year with a salary of \$88,000? Our STATE Legislators get about \$150,000 a year in salary and benefits.

What really bothers me about our STATE Legislators, they don't need a college degree or special certification to qualify and hold their job. Teachers are always under pressure to perform in their job and State mandates are required to hold their job.

In closing, we must always keep the pressure on our STATE Legislators to get what school retirees need most and that is a **COLA** in our pension. PASR is working on that for us.



Dauphin County PA School Retirees Presents

Delaware's Underground History

Tuesday, June 25, 2019

Spend a day in 19th century Delaware, the "First State" and the last stop on the Underground Railroad!

Our first visit of the day on the path of freedom is to Dover, the Capital City of the First State and visiting the **First State Heritage Park**, the urban "park without boundaries." Our visit includes a stop at the Old State House, Delaware's first permanent capital building, for a captivating interpretation of Delaware's Underground Railroad connection and courageous heroes.

Lunch today will be at **Where Pigs Fly**! Enjoy this local favorite, that specializes in hickory smoked pulled pork barbecue.

Afterwards, we venture to nearby Camden and explore the **Camden Friends Meeting House**, a Quaker house of worship constructed in 1805, where many members were actively involved in anti-slavery initiatives. Tour the rustic brick building and adjacent burial ground of prominent local heroes who assisted countless slaves in their quest for freedom and the conductors.

We end the day by visiting the **John Dickinson Plantation**, home of one of the founding fathers of the United States, signer of the U.S. Constitution, and "Penman of the Revolution." Here, we will enjoy a guided tour and learn about the plantation's close ties to the Underground Railroad.
