EXPENSES ARE GOING UP BUT OUR REVENUE IS NOT KEEPING UP

We have all been affected by rising costs. When you go to the store the prices of some items are enough to make your heart skip a beat. Costs for our organization are rising as well. We are dipping more and more into our general fund account, but replenishing funds are not coming in to cover what is being spent that is why we are considering raising the membership dues to <u>lifetime membership</u> fees \$200 and <u>yearly renewal fees</u> to \$40. This change would go into effect on July 1, 2020. This will apply to new members joining our organization only. If you are a current member you will be grandfathered and this increase will not affect you.

One prime example of rising costs is our newsletter. Did you know that it costs around \$600 each time to have our newsletter printed and sent to members? There is a form at the bottom of **Page 2** that you can fill out to get the newsletter electronically--this costs our organization nothing. I get mine electronically and really enjoy the convenience. If I feel like printing off a copy, I will. If not, I just deposit the newsletter into a folder where I can go to it whenever I need something. I can also just print off any form or information I need. Please consider signing up for electronic delivery.
