Next, we visit *Garrett County Museum of Transportation*, two-floors of exhibits featuring carriages, sleighs, buggies, fire department artifacts and automobiles, along with a representation of a blacksmith's shop.

Then, enjoy a buffet lunch at the *Penn Alps Restaurant*, plan to spend a few minutes in their craft shop after lunch!

Lastly, visit *Spruce Forest Artisan Village*, an arts and heritage center dedicated to preserving the heritage of the region. Resident and visiting artisans demonstrate their crafts in restored log cabins and vintage frame structures. You may get to see blacksmithing, weaving, wheel thrown pottery, bird sculpting, woodturning, and jewelry-smithing, among other crafts.
